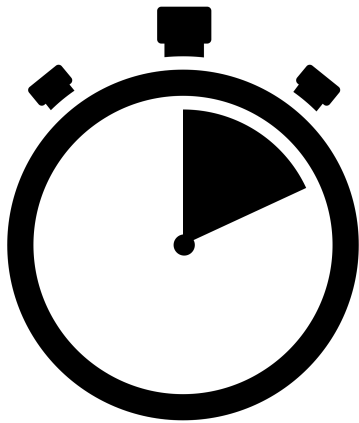

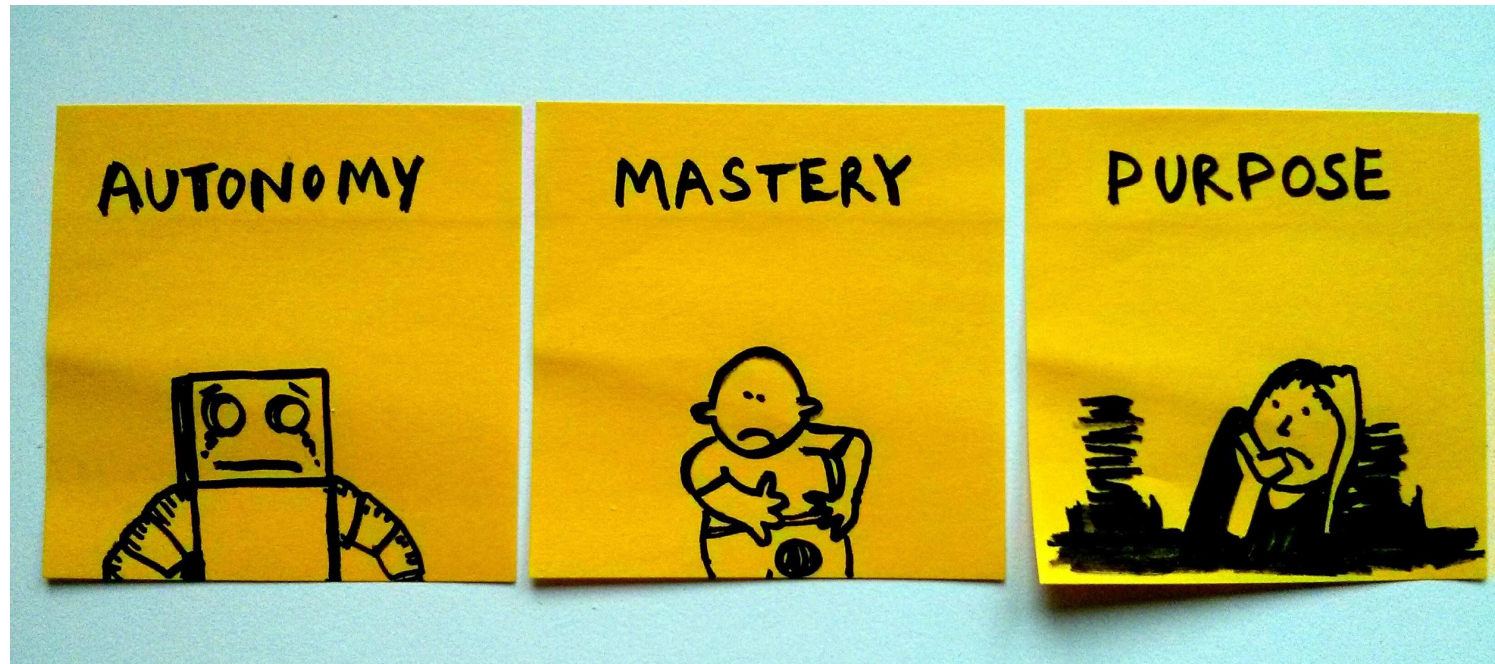

4 Main Types of Financial Assistance

- Scholarships & Grants- Money that does not have to be paid back. (Pell Grants FAFSA!!!) GI Bill- Military, etc...
- Loans- Educational loans are available through the government and private lending institutions. Most educational loans have low interest rates while payments deferred while you are in school. (Unsubsidized, Subsidized, Parent PLUS, Accruing Interest) Those are trouble words. Try to avoid!
- Work Study- Jobs that allow you to earn money to help pay expenses while enrolled in school. Most jobs are on the actual college campus, and some are non-profit organizations, but you can get one through the department of where you are majoring more than likely.

FAFSA

- The FAFSA is a FREE application that is done during your Senior Year when you are doing your scholarship and college applications. This qualifies a student for federal pell grant money. Most universities and scholarships require that you do the FAFSA. You will need to create an FSA ID for one student and one parent before you complete your FAFSA Application.
- Other Needs:
- FSA ID (One Student, One Parent: for Login)
- Social Security Number (If you don't have one utilize El Centro De La Raza)
- Valid ID#
- IRS 1040 Taxes from 2020 for 2022-2023 FAFSA Application
