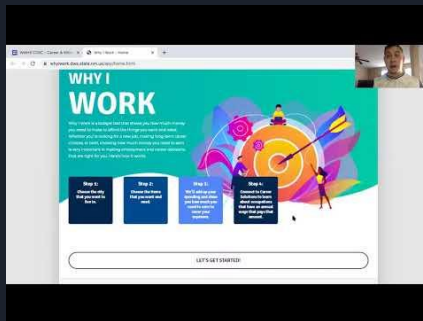
Oppti Instructions

Work Permit Link (If you are 15 & Younger)

- A Work Permit is required from the State of New Mexico if you have a job younger than the age of 16.
- Child Labor Laws in the State can only allow you to work until 7pm at night during school.
- An employer who employs you will fill out lines 5-9 on the permit and you fill out 1-4 and then you have a school official like Mr. Hartom or an administrator sign off on the permit.



Other Job Opportunities & Tips

- Check out the Job Boards in the Hallways by the Community School Office & the Counseling Office, even though we had them for the previous year many of those companies are hiring!
- They include: Dions, Mister Car Wash, Applebees, Fresquez Companies, UNM Facilities Management, TechHire, City of Albuquerque at Balloon Fiesta park, Lifeguard, etc.
- Balance Work and School, school always takes priority and it is hard when you do have to work but have a good work, school balance.
- Build A Resume and Cover Letters for a Potential Employer and list your attributes and experiences to potential employers.
