## **WHAT SHOULD PARENTS DO TO ENGAGE WITH ISB COMMUNICATIONS?**

*We ask parents to engage with all school communication to remain informed and up to date with what's happening in the community and in our classrooms. Maintaining contact with teachers and homeroom parents, informing ISB of any special needs your child may have, and being aware of and adhering to ISB's policies is important to ensure a strong partnership between school and home. Handbooks and policies around communication, as well as communication guides, can be found on Dragons' Gate.*

## **WHAT'S HAPPENING NEXT WEEK AT ISB?**

-- *ISB Weekly* – This is required reading for ALL parents and staff. High School students also receive the ISB Weekly. It is the weekly newsletter which includes important schoolwide and divisional news.

## **WHERE CAN I READ MORE ABOUT ISB'S PLANS?**

-- *From the Head of School* – This monthly letter from the Head of School is required reading for parents and staff as it provides high-level updates. Generally considered the place to find out about the strategic direction/philosophy of the school.

## **WHERE CAN I FIND THE SCHOOL HANDBOOKS?**

-- *Dragons' Gate* – This is the ISB handbook. It houses schoolwide policies and information as well as the Elementary, Middle, and High School handbooks. Logging into Dragons' Gate using your Dragon Account will give you access to all the key areas of information and links to ISB systems like PowerSchool, SchoolsBuddy, Dragons' Exchange.

## STUDENT PROGRESS: PARENTS CAN KEEP UP TO DATE WITH THEIR CHILDREN'S LEARNING THROUGH TWO ONLINE TOOLS.

-- *Seesaw* – The online learning journal and parent communication tool for Elementary School. Student updates and class news are shared weekly. You can access the information via the Seesaw app.

-- *Dragons' Exchange* – The online learning platform for Middle and High School students. Classroom updates shared once every cycle (five-eight days). You can access this through Dragons' Gate.

Report cards are also sent home once per semester, and parents have the opportunity to meet teachers face to face at our Parent Teacher Conferences, once per semester.



## HOW CAN I LEARN ABOUT THE ISB CURRICULUM?

The Curriculum pages on our website provide high-level information. You can also attend our regular Parent Coffees and workshops to learn more about teaching and learning at ISB.

## I MISSED A PARENT/ COUNSELOR COFFEE – CAN I REVIEW THE SLIDES?

-- *Parent Presentations* – Couldn't make it to the Head of School Coffee, or a Counselor Coffee? Or just want to review what was discussed? Visit Dragons' Gate for an archive of parent presentations.

## WHERE CAN I FIND PHOTOS OF AN EVENT?

-- *Vidigami* – Accessed through Dragons' Gate by logging in with your Dragon Account, this is the ISB community photo album. Build your own albums of your children by tagging them in photos and upload your own photos of ISB events to share with the community.



## WHERE CAN I SEE WHAT'S COMING UP AT ISB?

-- *ISB Calendar* – If it's not on the calendar, it's not happening! THE place to find out everything that's going on at ISB, so you don't miss out.



## DOES ISB HAVE A WECHAT MINI PROGRAM?

Yes! Dragon Connect is ISB's very own mini program providing easier access to our data portal, PowerSchool. We will also be adding new features to the mini program over the coming months. **ABSENCE REPORTING**

**HOW DO I REPORT IF MY CHILD WILL BE ABSENT?**

We've created a form to make it easier to report any absences for your child. Scan the QR code to the left to report planned absences and illness. In Elementary School, you can also use this form to report changes to pick-up/drop-off.

**WHO SHOULD I CONTACT IF I HAVE A QUESTION/CONCERN?**

For issues related to teaching, learning, and student behavior, the first point of contact should be your child's teacher or one of the counselors in the division.

For non-instructional questions or concerns, contact the appropriate department.

You can expect an initial response within 24 hours.

**WHEN CAN I EXPECT A RESPONSE TO MY EMAIL THAT I SENT TO MY CHILD'S TEACHER/DIVISION?**

We aim to respond to all emails within 24 hours of receipt. This may be an initial acknowledgement if your query requires further investigation, but we will let you know.
