

1A Evergreen League Event Spectator Guidelines

We are very happy the 1A Evergreen League student-athletes get to have the opportunity to finally compete and perform on the field and court. Out of an abundance of caution for the safety and well-being of our students, and to help maintain their opportunity to have contests, we are establishing the following spectator conditions for Season 1 contests. We appreciate everyone's cooperation in abiding by the guidelines and support of student activities.

Elma School District Wellness Check

1. **Do you have any of the following symptoms not caused by another condition?** Fever of 100.4 or above, body aches/chills, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea, cough, shortness of breath, congestion, runny nose, new loss of taste/smell, vomiting?
2. **Have you had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 10 days?**
3. **Have you been in close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes/day) with anyone with a confirmed case of COVID-19?**
4. **Has a medical professional told you that you need to self-isolate or quarantine due to concerns about COVID-19 in the past 14 days?**

Cross Country & Boys Golf:

1. Home & away fans are permissible.
2. Spectator are encouraged to follow safety protocols, including physical distancing, and proper mask wearing at all times.
3. Wellness screening/attestation will not be conducted for spectators.
4. 200 max, which includes all participants, coaches, staff, & spectators.

Football:

1. **VARSDITY** - No VISITING team fans or the general public allowed.
2. **HOME** uniformed **seniors** on the Football, Cheer, and Fall Drill team roster will receive two (2) guests per home contest. Admission is FREE!
3. **JV/C Contests** – HOME and VISITING uniformed players will receive two (2) guests per home contest.
4. Wellness screening/attestation protocol is required for entry. Guests with CoVid-19 symptoms are prohibited from attending.
5. Guests must sign in.
6. Following safety protocols, including physical distancing, and proper mask wearing is required at all times.
7. Locker rooms are off limits. Home and away teams and officials are required to show up at the game site dressed ready for competition.
8. No concessions will be available. Restrooms will be open & accessible for all participants, contest personnel, and guests.

Girls Soccer: Beginning 2/22/21

1. VISITING VARSITY uniformed players may have two (2) guests each.
2. HOME JV & VARSITY uniformed players may have two (2) guests each.
3. Admission is FREE!
4. Guests must sign in.
5. Wellness screening/attestation protocol is required for entry. Guests with CoVid-19 symptoms are prohibited from attending.
6. Following safety protocols, including physical distancing, and proper mask wearing is required at all times.
7. Locker rooms are off limits. Home and away teams and officials are required to show up at the game site dressed ready for competition.
8. No concessions will be available.
9. Restrooms will be open & accessible for all participants, contest personnel, and guests.
10. Teams will be on opposite sides of the field.

Volleyball: Varsity, JV, & C – beginning 3/1/21

1. HOME and VISITING uniformed players may have two (2) guests each. Admission is FREE!
2. Guests must sign in.
3. Wellness screening/attestation protocol is required for entry. Guests with CoVid-19 symptoms are prohibited from attending.
4. Following safety protocols, including physical distancing, and proper mask wearing is required at all times. Please use the social distancing “feet” stickers for spacing.
5. Locker rooms are off limits. Home and away teams and officials are required to show up at the game site dressed ready for competition.
6. No concessions will be available. NO food or drink allowed in the gym. Please consume outside food and drink in the Commons.
7. Restrooms will be open & accessible for all participants, contest personnel, and guests.
8. Teams will not exchange sides.
9. Guests must leave after their player’s contest is completed. If swing player, guest must exit and re-enter for next contest. Guests may enter the gym after the previous team and spectators have exited and the facility is safe to enter.
