APPLING COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM INTRADISTRICT TRANSFER LETTER FOR 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

To All Parents and Guardians of K-5 Students of Appling County School System

RE: House Bill 251 was passed in July 2009 and it covers Public School Choice

As the parent or guardian of a student currently enrolled in our school system, you are being notified that under Georgia State Law:

The Intradistrict Transfer Option allows a parent/guardian the option to request a transfer from their child's assigned school to a school of the parent's choice within the school zone/district that their child resides. The Intradistrict Transfer may be granted to your child only if the school to which the request for transfer has classroom space available after all the assigned students have been enrolled.

Parents Responsibilities:

Please keep in mind that if you choose to transfer your child to another school in the system, the law requires you to assume **all cost and responsibilities related to the transportation of your child to and from the school as long as your child remains at the school.**

At this time, Appling County Elementary Complex has limited available classroom space for this upcoming school year. In order to process your request, you will need to complete and submit the "Transfer Request Form" which is posted on the Appling County School System's website (www.appling.k12.ga.us) under Title I forms or is available at the Appling County Board of Education. **Request for transfers will not be accepted after 4:30 p.m. on July 6, 2023.**

Transfer requests will be approved or denied on a first come, first serve basis, depending on the school's available space. *Once available classroom space is reached at a school, no more transfers will be accepted at that school.* House Bill 251 will be followed for all students in the Appling County School District including PK students.
