Appling BOE Names Dr. Janet Goodman as Sole Finalist for Superintendent of Schools.

June 7, 2023

The Appling County Board of Education continues its process to name a new superintendent for Appling County Schools.

The Board was excited to receive 16 applications for this position. The Board initially narrowed this field to six candidates and invited these candidates to Appling County for interviews. The Board was pleased to have many well-qualified applicants but Dr. Janet Goodman emerged from the interview process as an outstanding candidate who the Board believes will be a great fit for the Appling County School System, but; also a great asset to our community.

Pursuant to Georgia law, the Board must wait at least 14 calendar days before taking final action on the position. The Board is further required to make available to the public documents for inspection and review of our chosen finalist.

During a called Board meeting on June 6, 2023, Dr. Goodman was named by the Board to be the best qualified for the position and was chosen as the Board's sole candidate. Information on Dr. Goodman will be made available at the Central Office and will be posted on the school system website.

The Board is confident in Dr. Goodman's leadership and believes that she has the experience and knowledge to lead the Appling County School System.

The Board intends to have Dr. Goodman in place before the end of June.

Dear Appling County Board Members:

I am writing this letter of interest for the Superintendent of Appling County School System. As a teacher and administrator in all levels of education, from preschool through university level, I have seen documented improvement in student achievement, behavior, and school culture by building relationships, engaging the students and community, and providing intentional training and support for all teachers and administrators. I currently serve as Interim Superintendent in Pickens County School District where I was first hired as Federal Programs Director in August, 2021. In March, 2022, I was asked to serve as the Chief Academic Officer and rebuild the Curriculum and Instruction Department to ensure that our district focused on the right work—students reaching their full potential and mastering the curriculum and engaging all stakeholders in this mission. In my short time in Pickens County we have successfully rolled out the Thinking Maps® initiative and redesigned our district's Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) to support every child in reaching their goals. Additionally, we offered an enrichment summer camp where our students engaged in project-based learning and engaging experiences that were developed through a shared leadership approach.

I have attached my resume for your review of the various positions I have held in Pickens and Haralson County schools and Florida, including Interim Superintendent. What is not on my resume is the incredible academic progress I have witnessed in my time in Pickens County as evidenced by the growth on our quarterly benchmarks and Georgia Milestones. We continually examine student and teacher data and support schools in the continuous improvement process to ensure mastery for all students by fostering a positive learning environment.

Before moving to Pickens County, I spent fourteen years in Haralson County School District as a supervisor in Federal Programs, Teaching and Learning, Student Supports, and Human Resources. In the 10 years since I moved into the position of Chief Academic Officer in Haralson we were able to move our graduation rate from 57.0% in 2011 to 98% in 2021. Additionally, our students with disabilities graduation rate improved from 23.2% in 2011 to 97.3% in 2021. As the district Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) Coordinator I supported the schools in improving culture and climate as evidenced by increased school attendance and greatly reduced discipline referrals. As the Director of Federal Programs, I was able to support Haralson County High School in being recognized as a Title I Reward school twice in two years. This tremendous growth can be attributed to a laser focus on improving instruction, attendance, and behavior through strategic planning and district initiatives, as well as continually analyzing data to improve instruction for all students. Through this work in schools I have written and presented on many evidence-based strategies, including several publications on how to improve outcomes for all students.

If given the opportunity to serve Appling County School System as Superintendent I would strive to support administrators, teachers, and students in achieving their goals, and thereby securing a successful future for the students and the community. In doing so I hope to move Appling County School System towards excellence in all areas of education. I look forward to speaking with the Appling County BOE about their vision for all students and staff as they are poised and ready to reach their highest goals.
