## Boys' School's Uniform (Years 7-11)

The School's aim in its choice of uniform is that the boys at Dame Allan's should look smart, businesslike, and represent their school well. To this end, we have chosen a uniform that is both practical and hard-wearing and we rely on the co-operation of both parents and pupils in maintaining a high standard of dress. The major uniform items must be purchased from our official suppliers Schoolblazer. Correct school uniform must be worn in school and during journeys to and from school. We expect boys to be clean shaven and hair to be smart, tidy and of a natural colour. If boys' hair is longer, so that it covers the blazer collar, we expect them to tie it back smartly, in the same way that girls who wear long hair are required to do.

As is the case with girls, jewellery and piercings are not allowed with the exception of a watch and a pair of small, plain ear studs which may be worn, one in each lobe.

### Uniform

- A plain dark coloured or black coat, fleece or school regulation PE splash jacket (excluding any garment made of denim, leather or suede). Games kit or other hoodies may not be worn as a coat or under the blazer.
- Regulation. Black school blazer with maroon trim and lining and embroidered school crest
- Regulation. School tie
- Regulation. School uniform style charcoal grey trousers (chinos, cotton, linen, denim, or tight fitting trousers are not allowed)
- · White shirt, long or short sleeved
- Regulation. Years 7-9 Maroon "V" neck vest with black neck band
- Regulation. Years 10-11 Black "V" neck vest with maroon neck band
- Plain socks dark grey or black.
- Conventional school uniform shoes, black throughout. No trainers or other casual shoes.

## Exemption from PE and games
