**\*\*Please keep notes for each chapter. Notes will be checked in class. If you know who your teacher will be, share a Google Doc when you begin.**

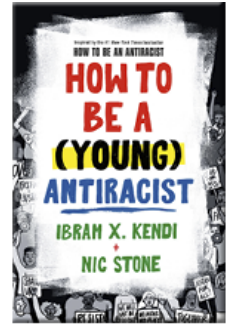

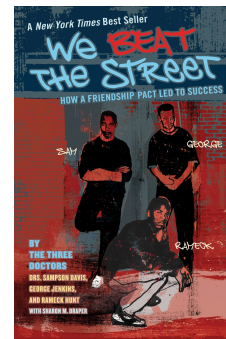
