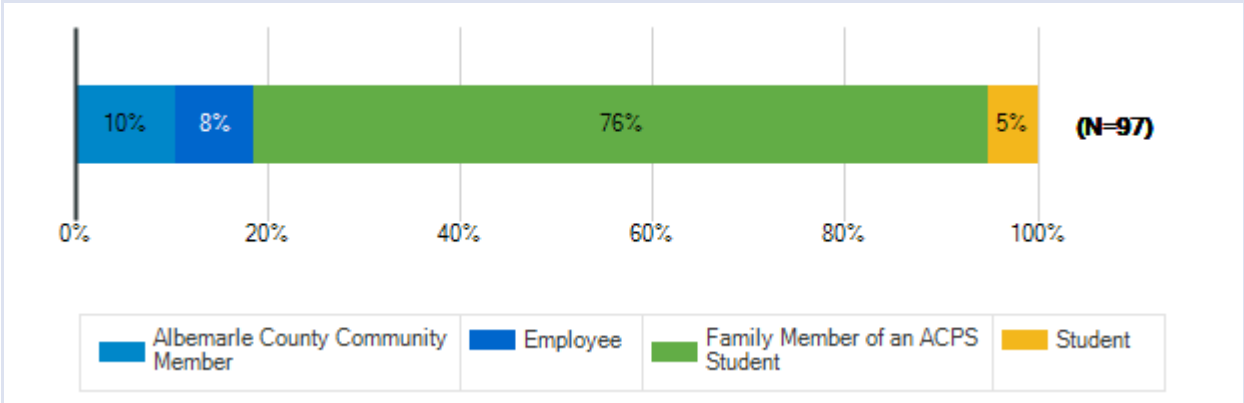

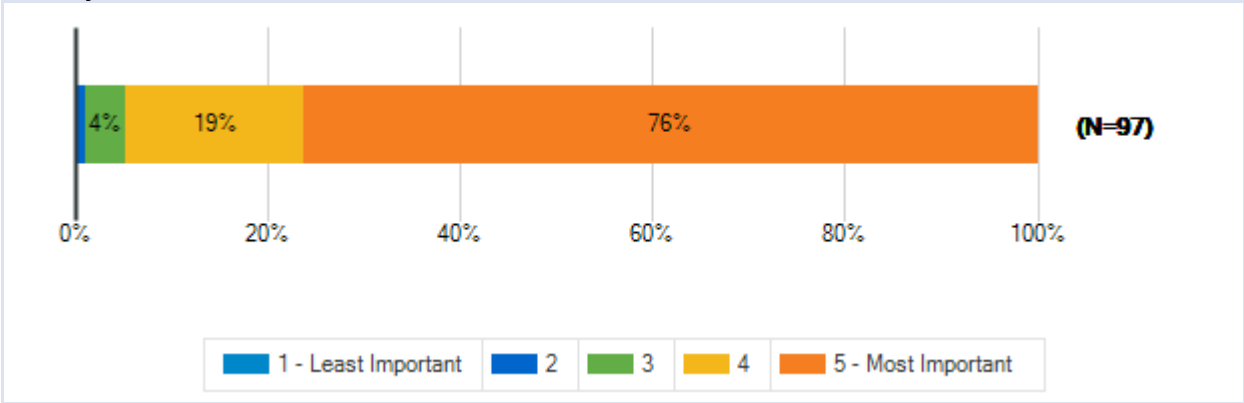

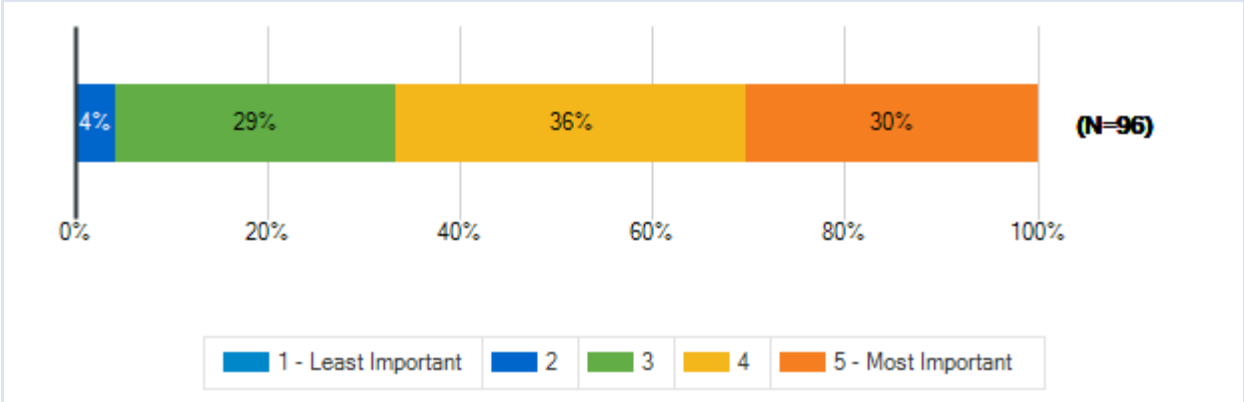

What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Safety & Security

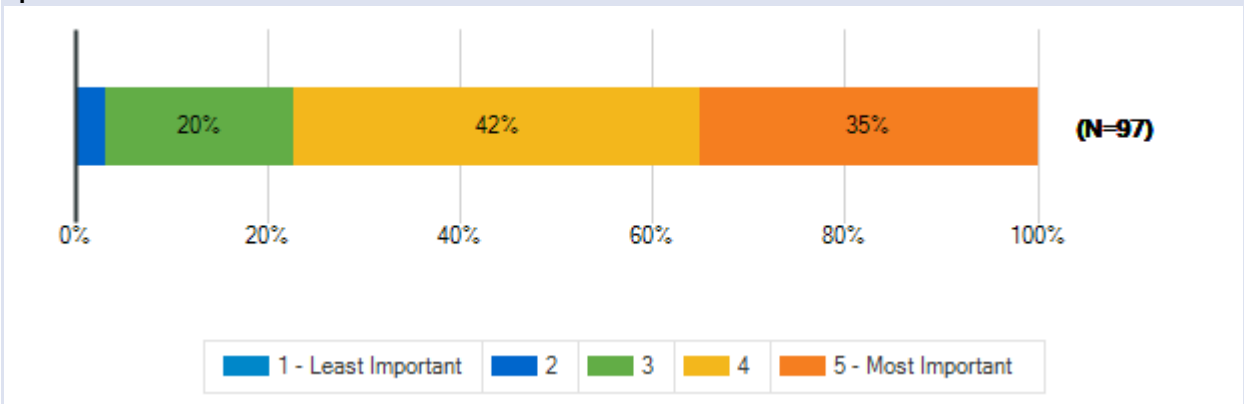


What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Growth & Capacity

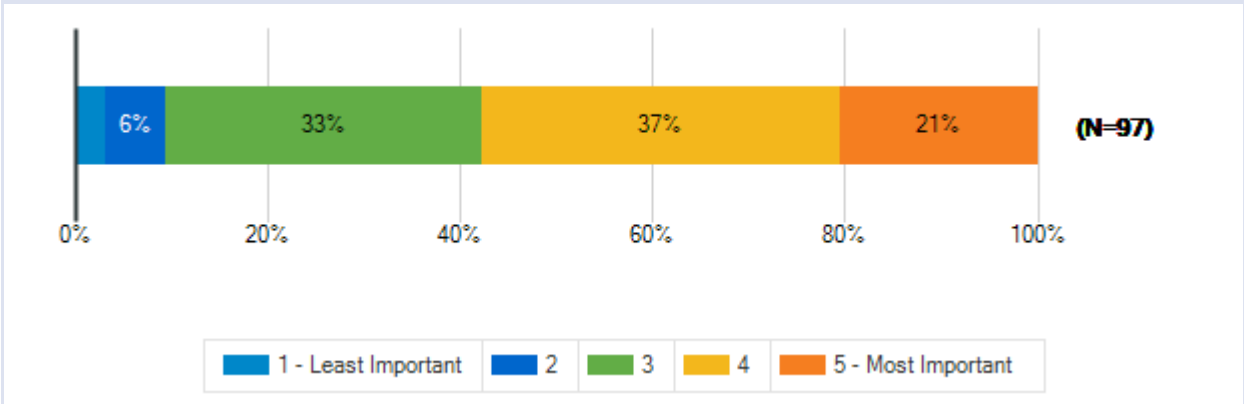

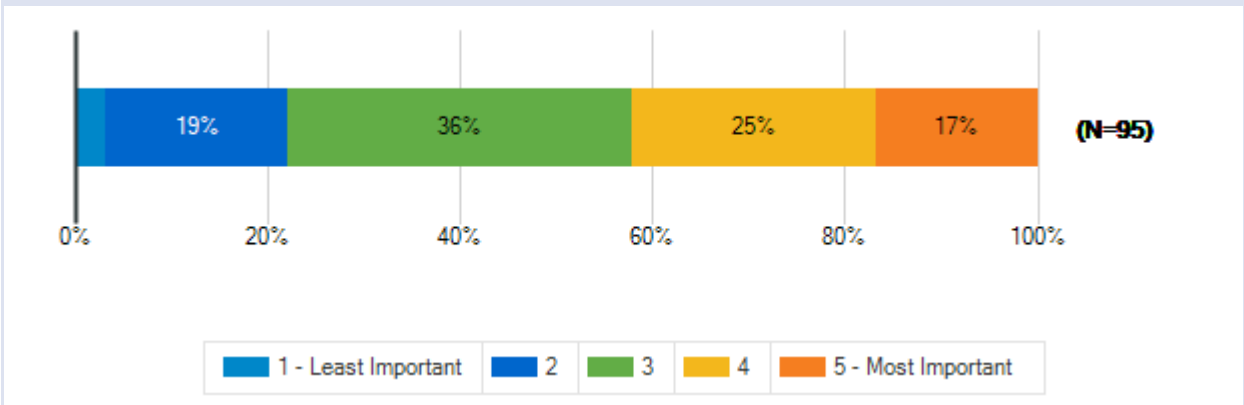
What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Outdoor Spaces



What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Sustainability & Natural Resources

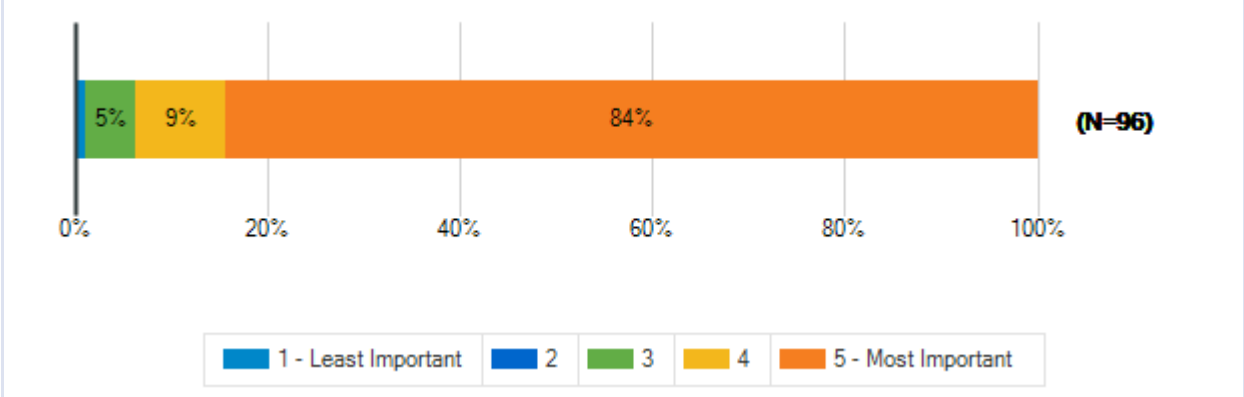


What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Community Access & Amenities

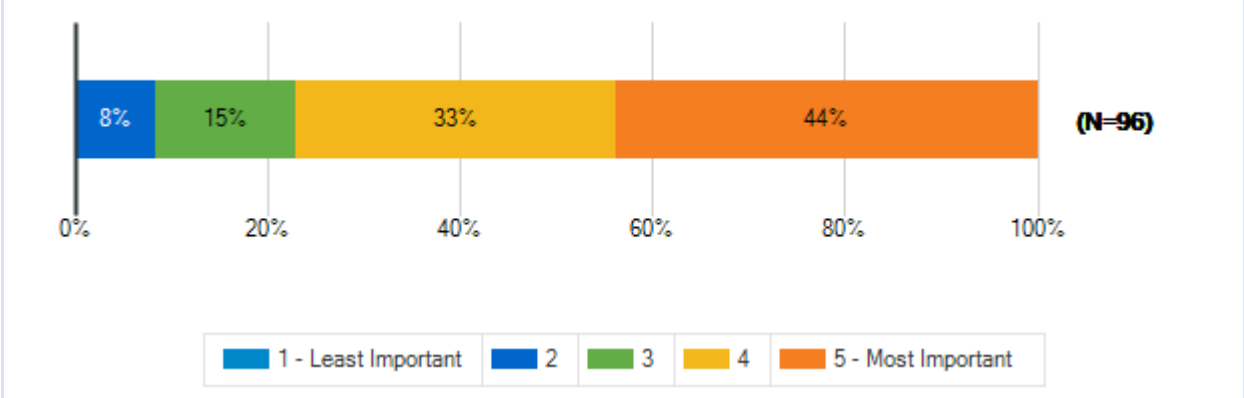

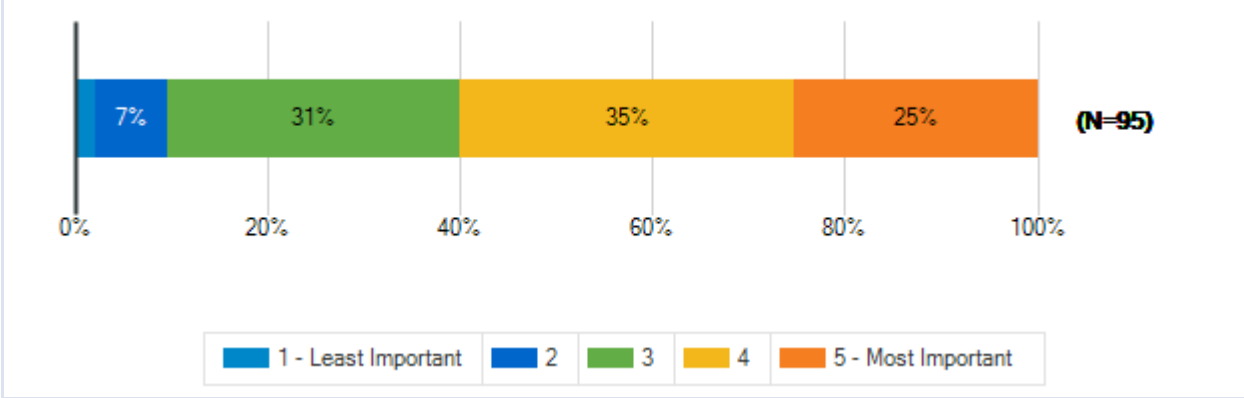
What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Positive, Healthy Culture



What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Welcoming, Comfortable, Aesthetic Spaces

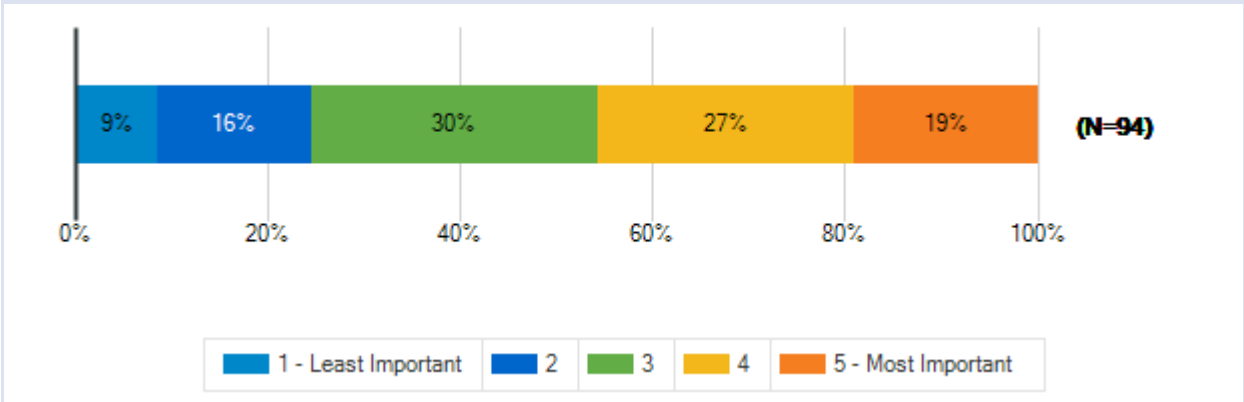


What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Durability, Flexibility, Cost-Efficiency

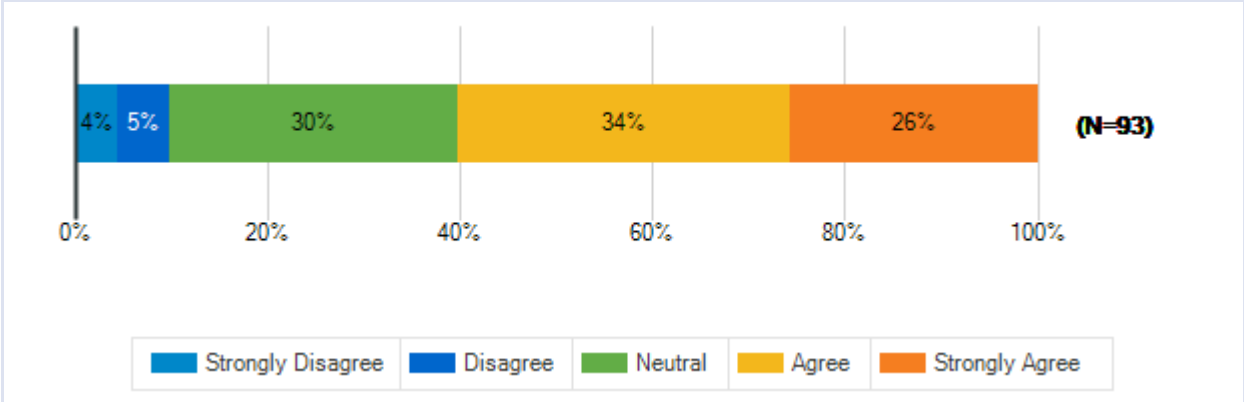

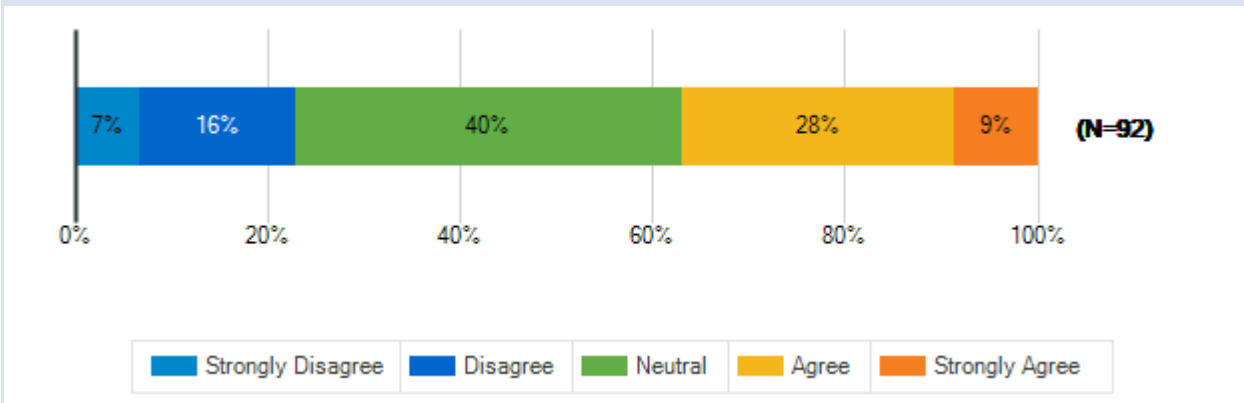
What are the most important qualities for middle school sites/grounds in the 21st century? : Sustainable/Net-Zero Construction



To what extent does your middle school support the following?: A sense of pride and well-being in staff and students

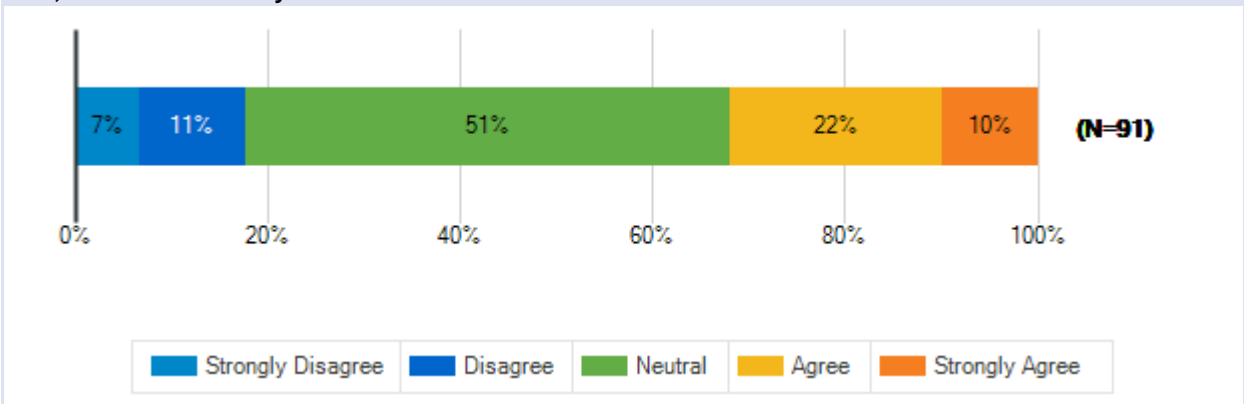


To what extent does your middle school support the following?: Prioritizing the outdoor environment

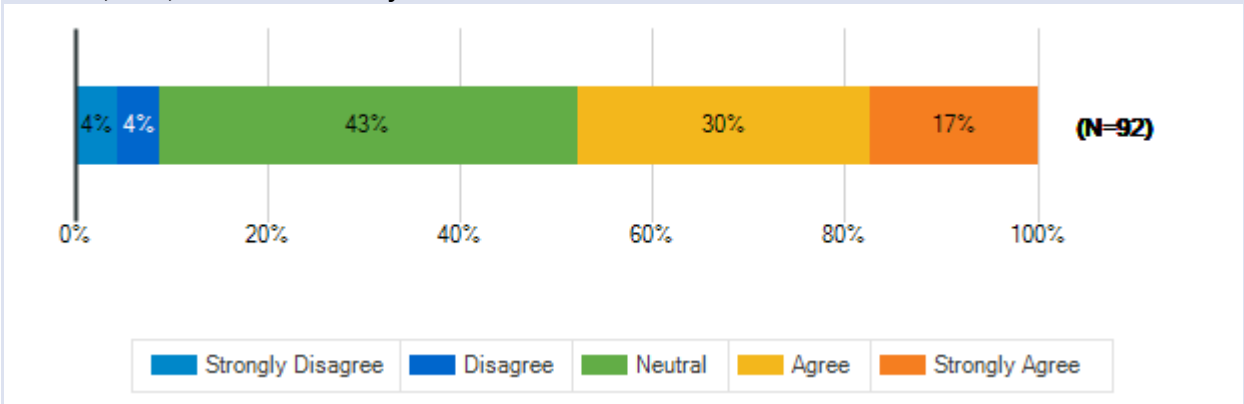

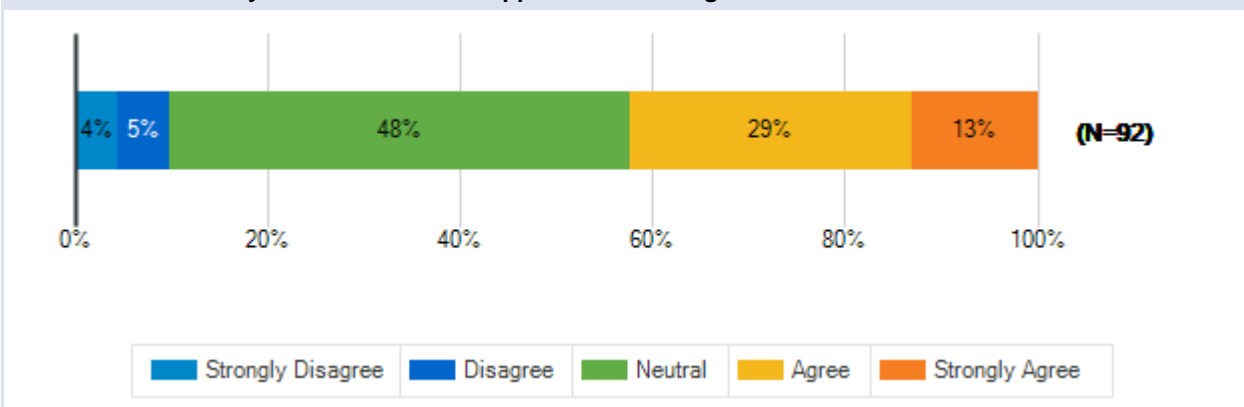
To what extent does your middle school support the following?: Natural resources available to students, staff, and the community



To what extent does your middle school support the following?: Educational resources available to students, staff, and the community

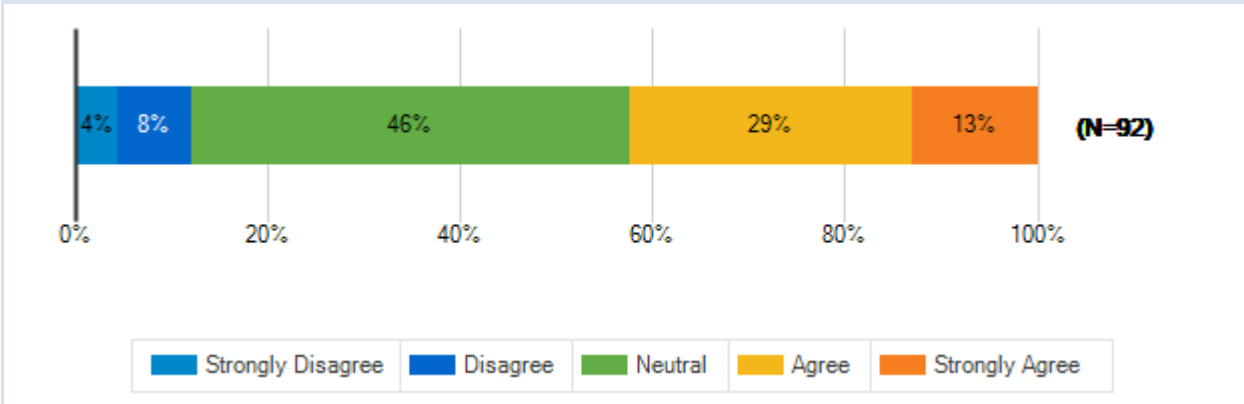


To what extent does your middle school support the following?: Health and fitness

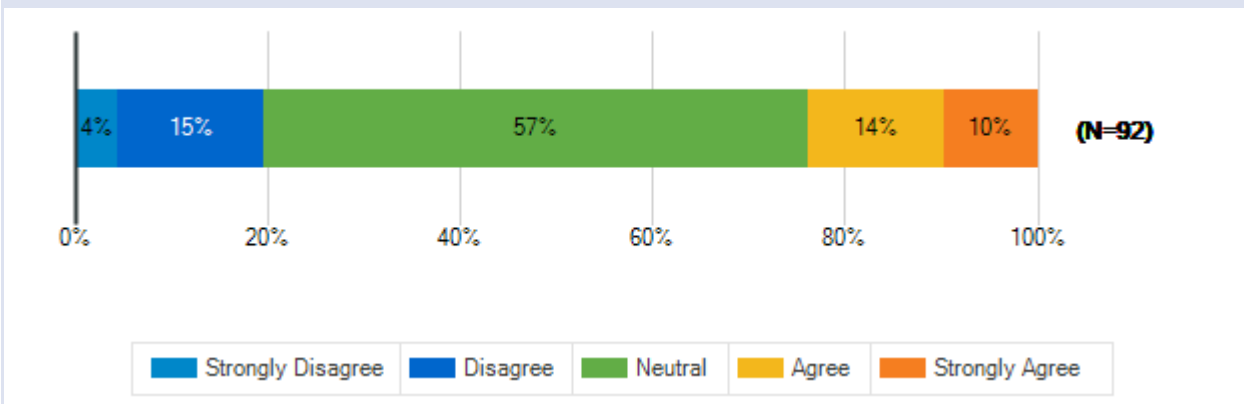

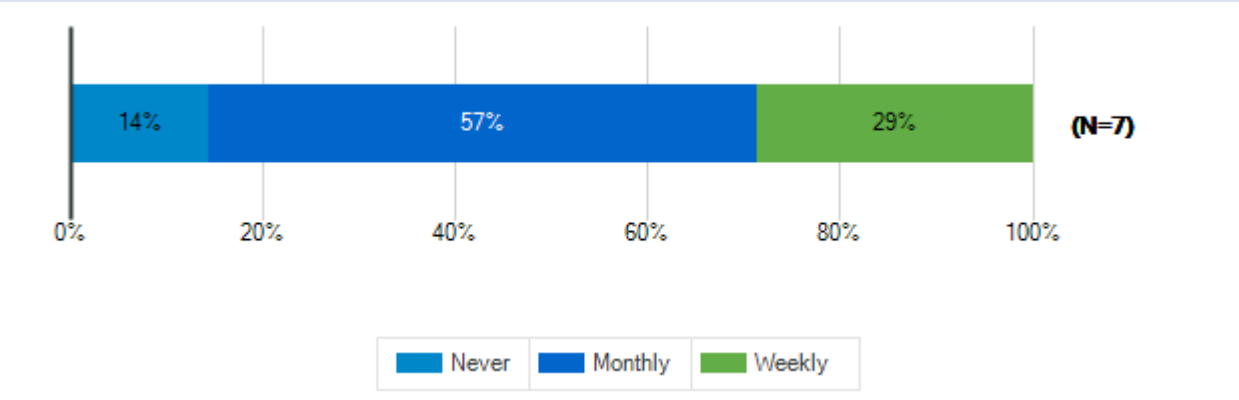
How often do you use?: Teacher Work Rooms

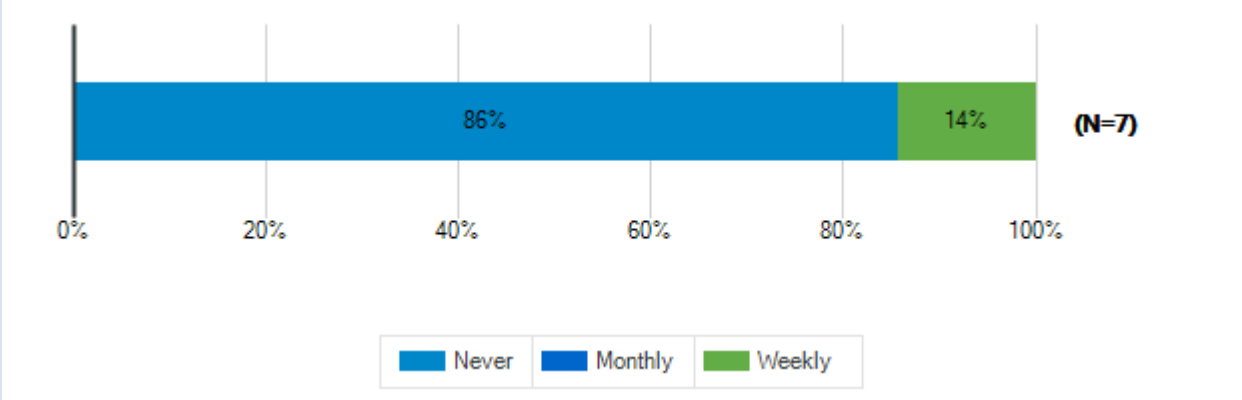

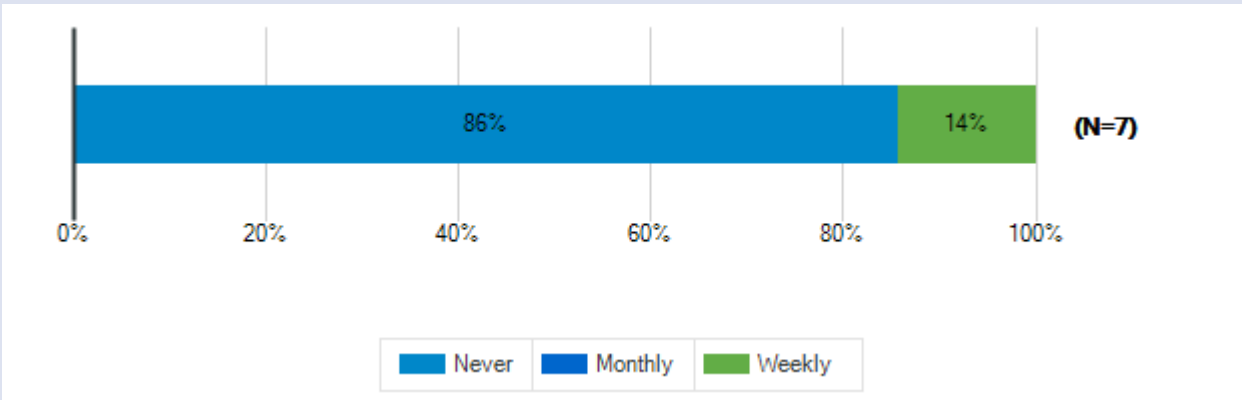

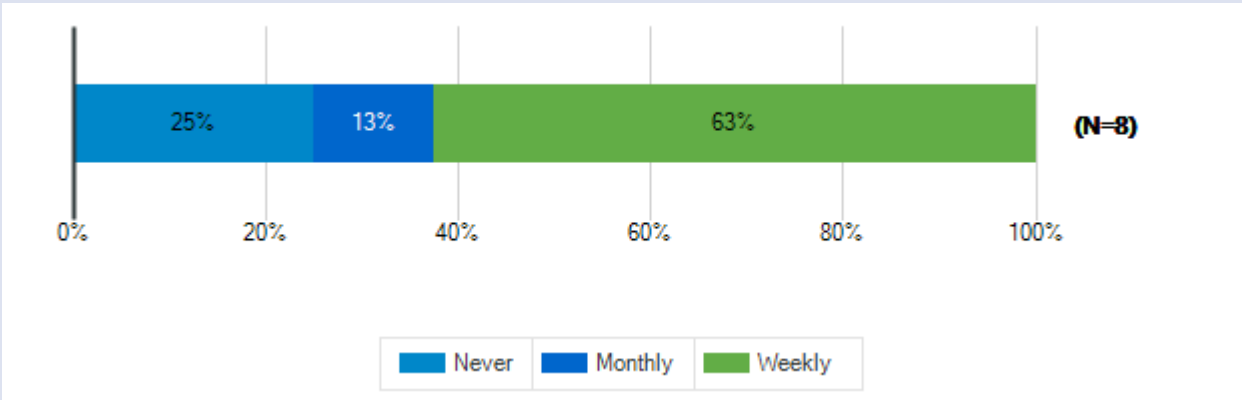
How often do you use?: Stage/Auditorium

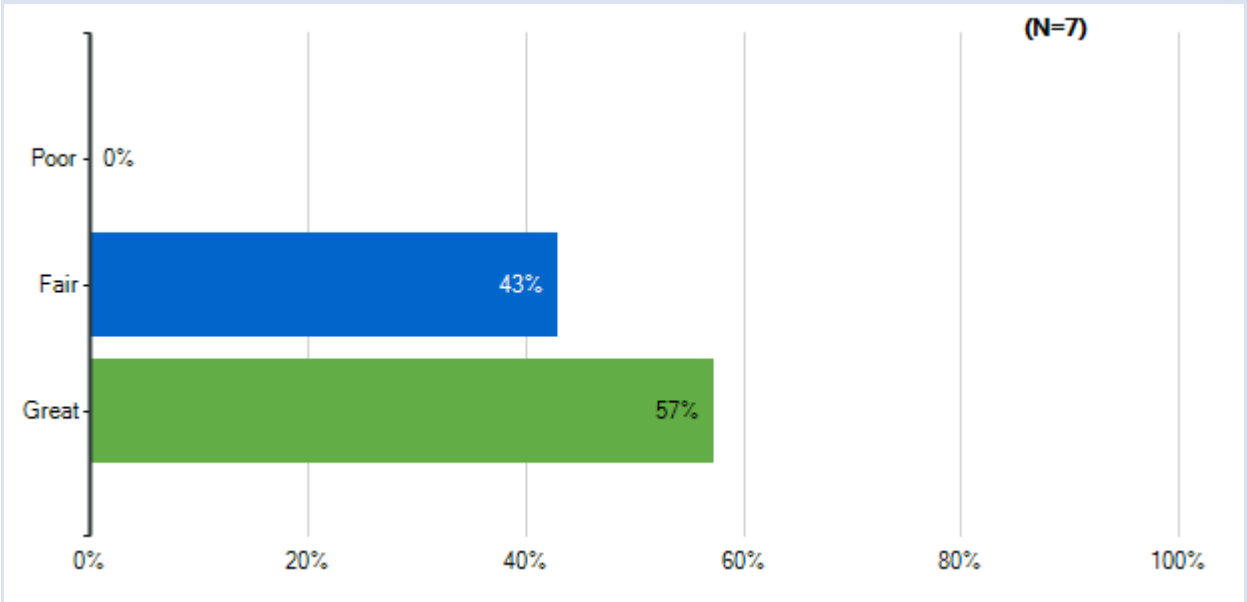
How would you rate the quality?: Teacher Lounge

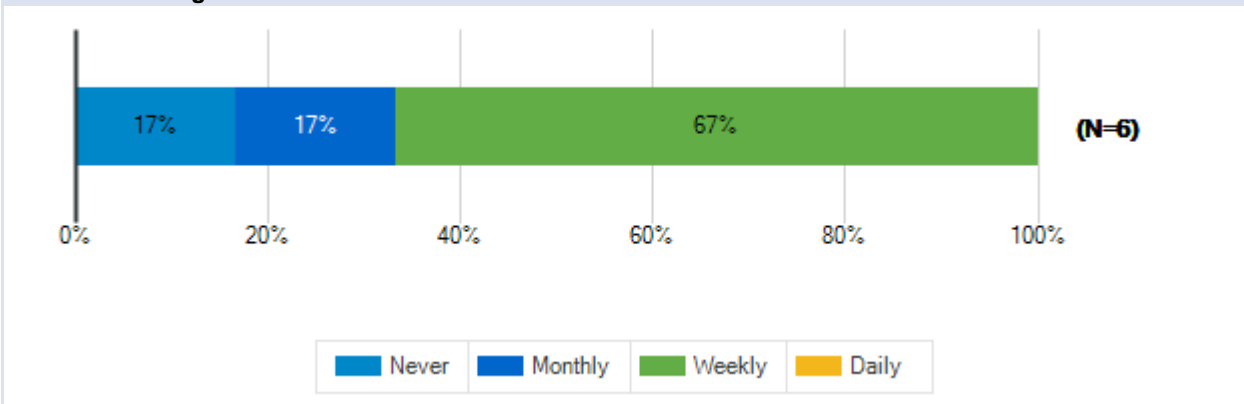


How frequently do your students engage in the following activities in your classroom: **Lecture/Lessons**

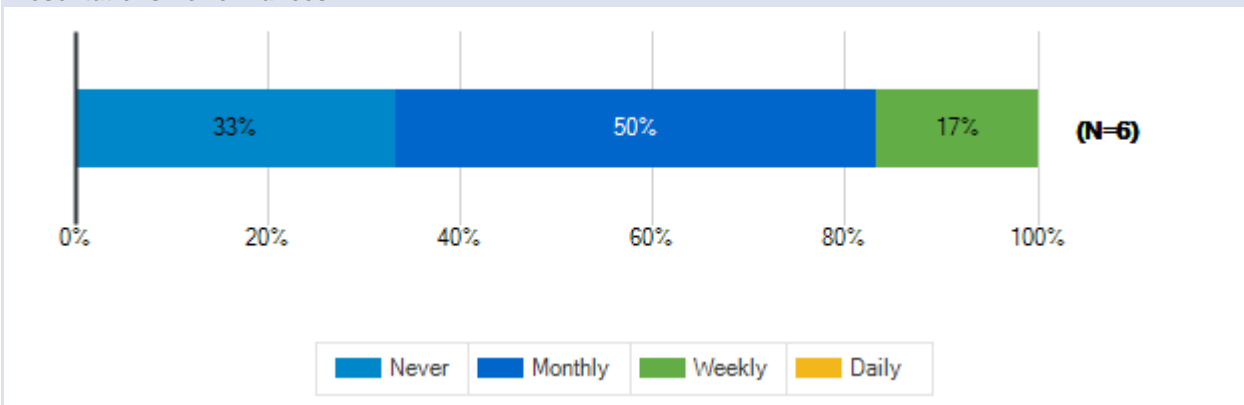

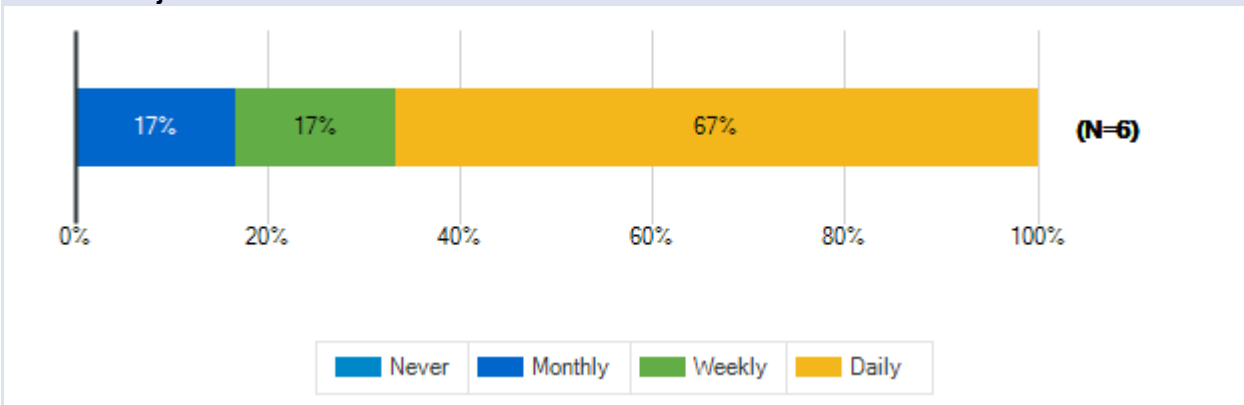
How frequently do your students engage in the following activities in your classroom: Learning Centers/Listening Stations



How frequently do your students engage in the following activities in your classroom: Student Presentations Performances

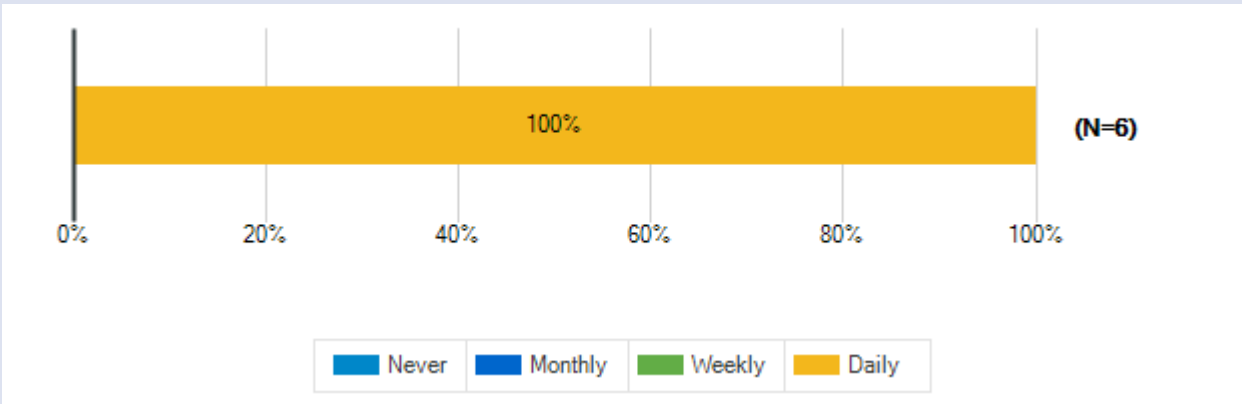

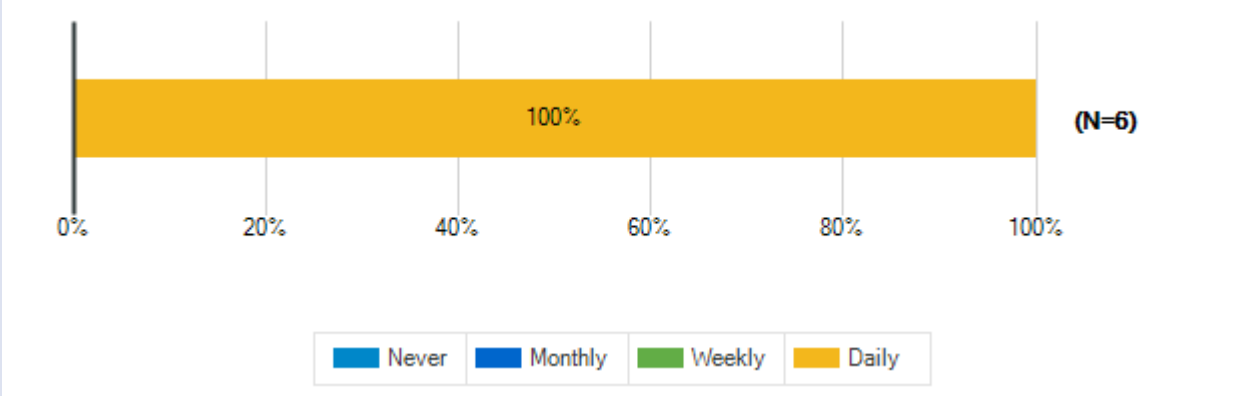

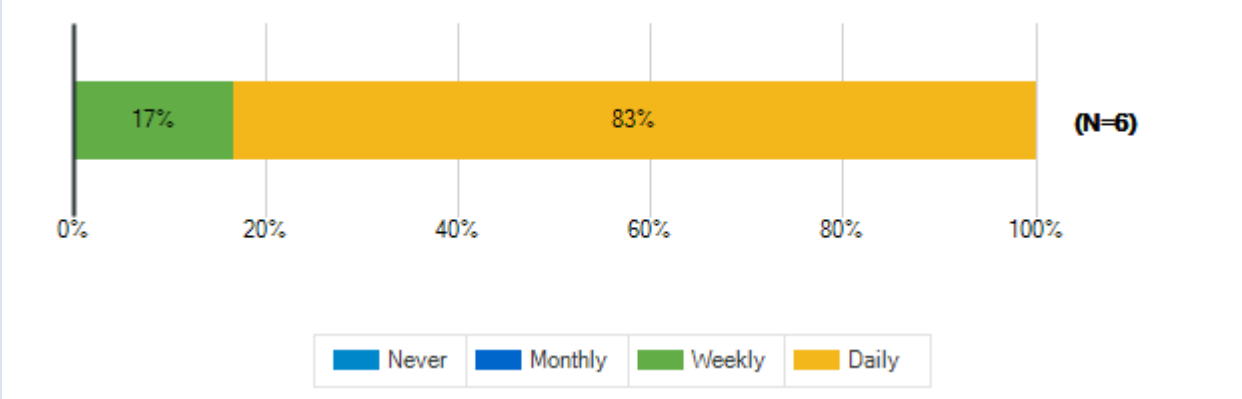
How frequently do your students engage in the following activities in your classroom: Individual Work

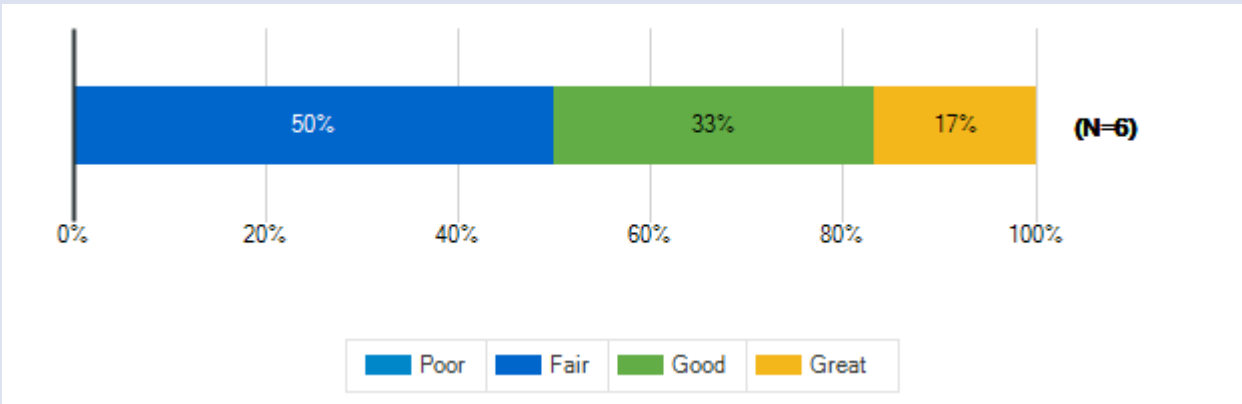


How frequently do your students engage in the following activities in your classroom: Physical Activity/Movement Breaks

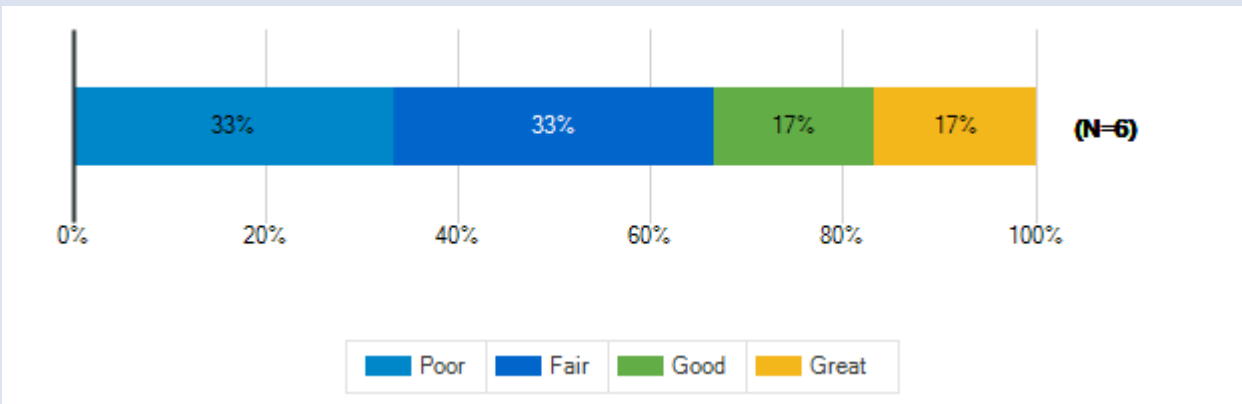

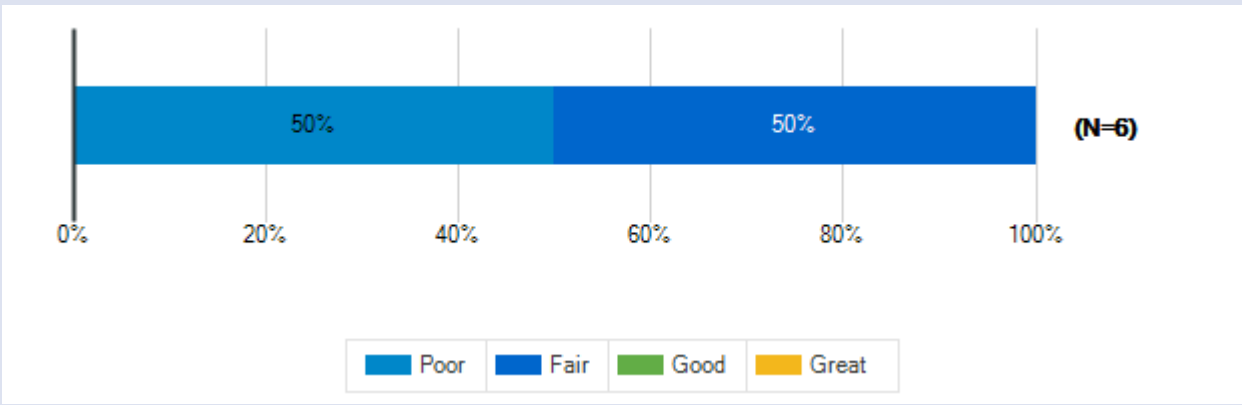
How would you describe the following characteristics of your classroom?: Location

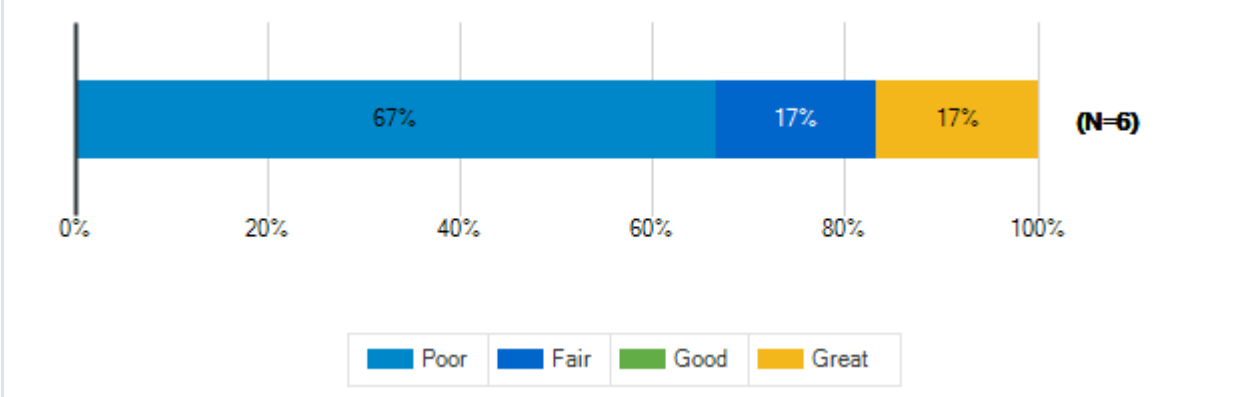

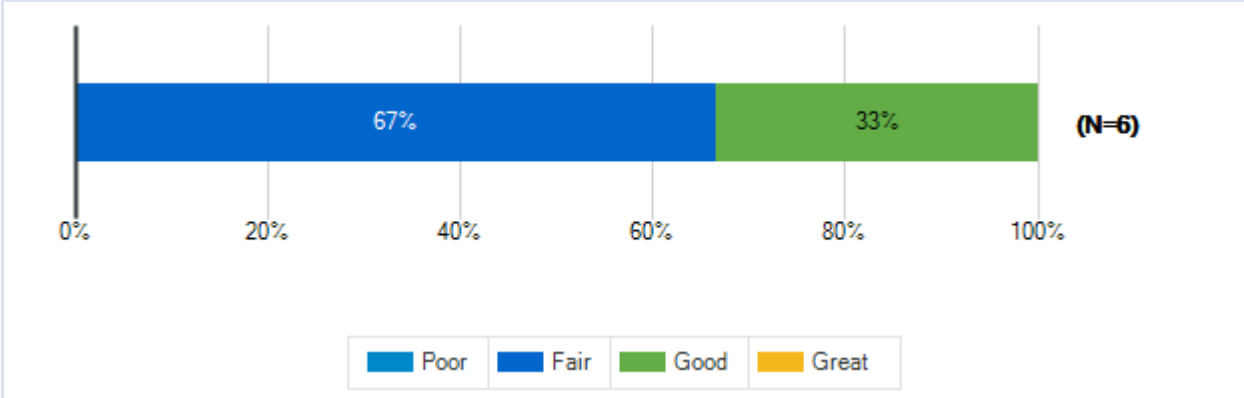

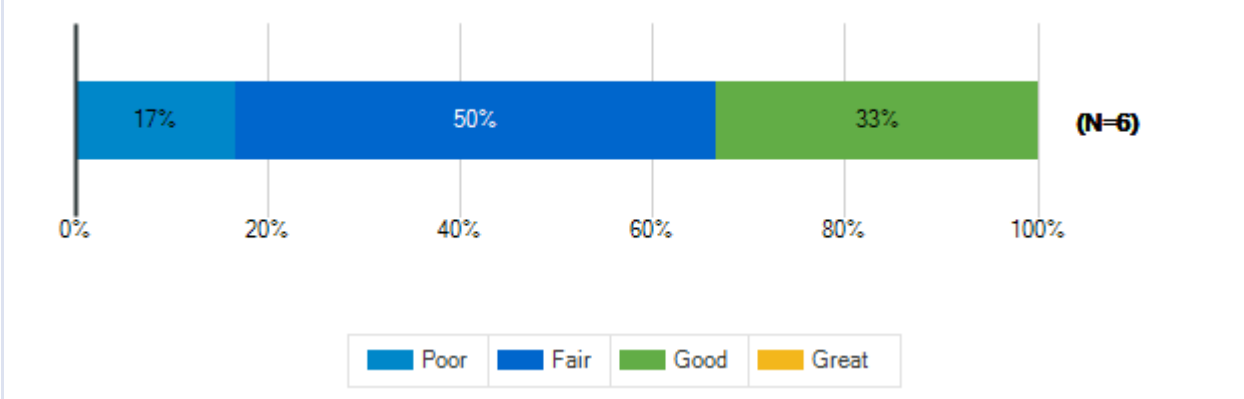
How would you describe the following characteristics of your classroom?: Storage (Amount, Design, Location)

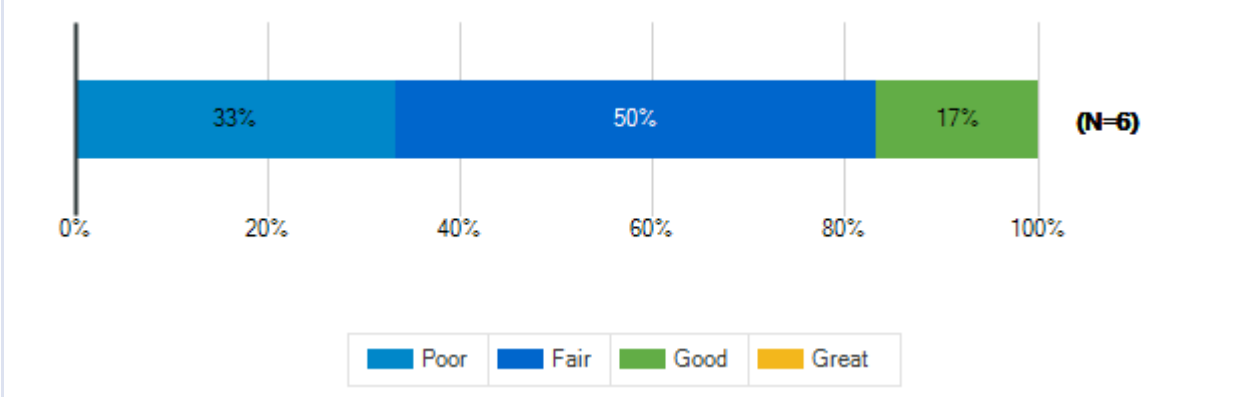


How would you describe the following characteristics of your classroom?: Availability of Technology (including WiFi & power outlets)

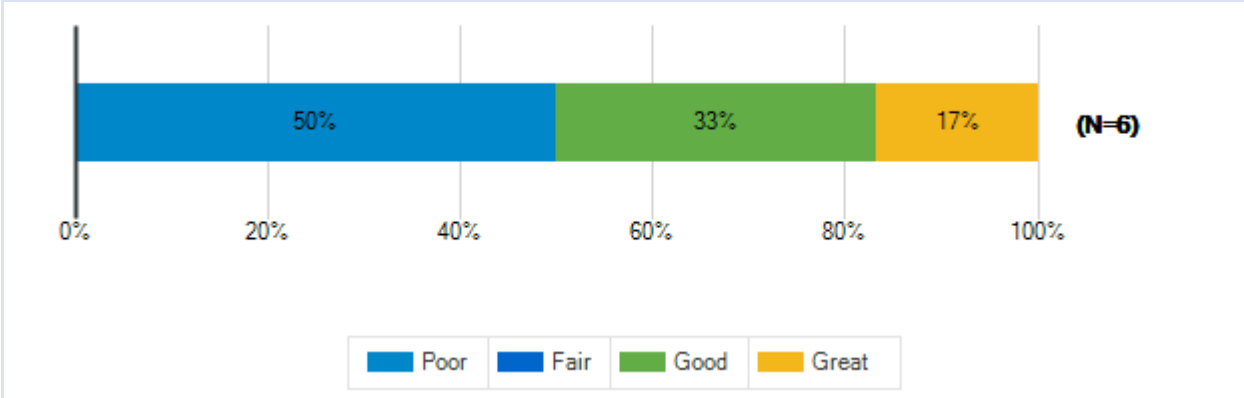

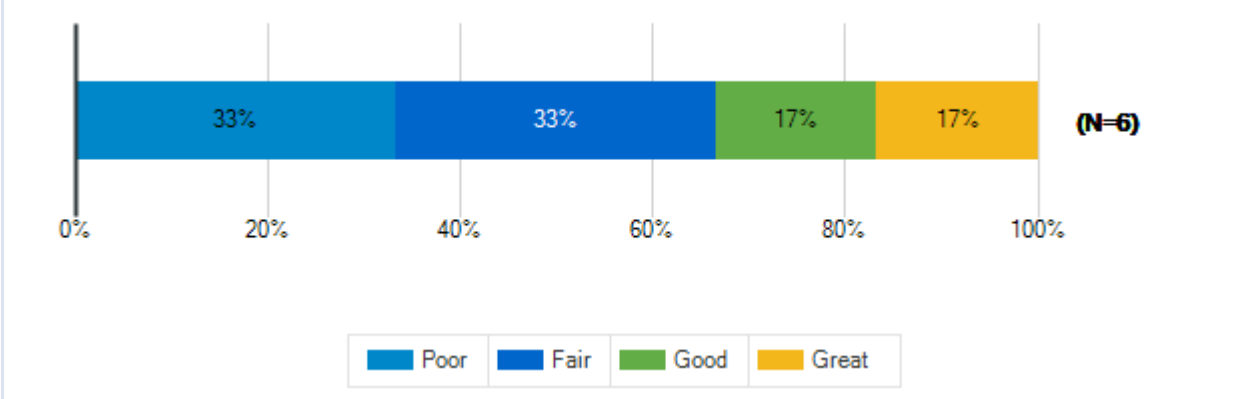
How would you describe the following characteristics of your classroom?: Functionality (including versatility and adaptability)

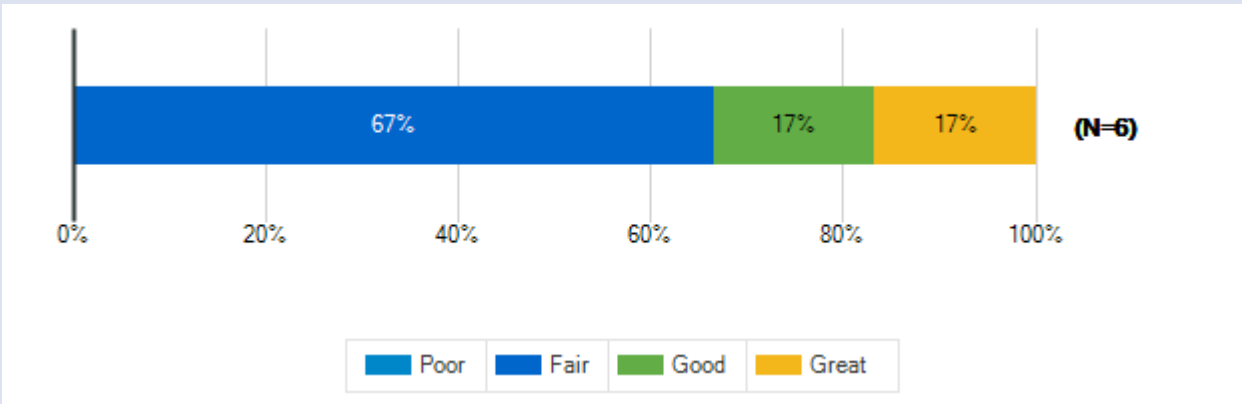


How would you describe the following characteristics of your classroom?: Access to Outdoor Spaces and/or Outdoor Visibility

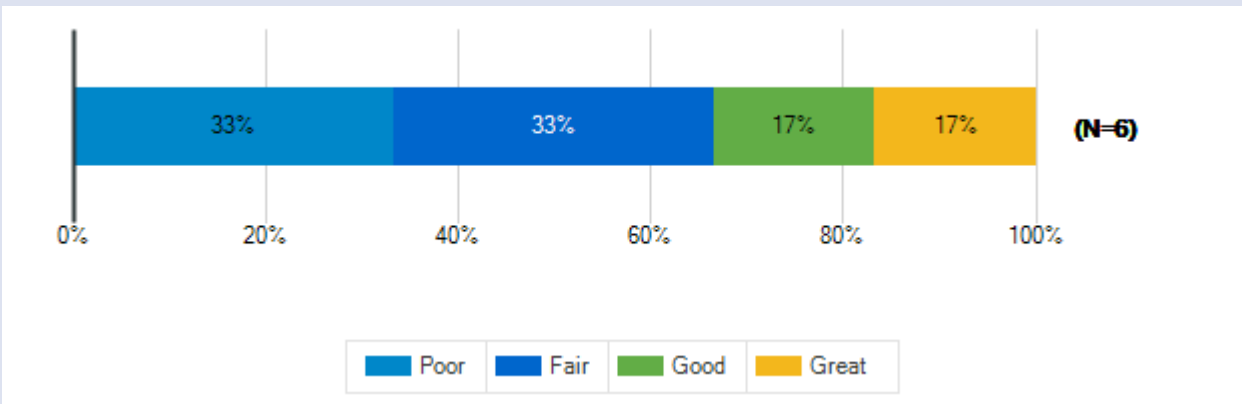

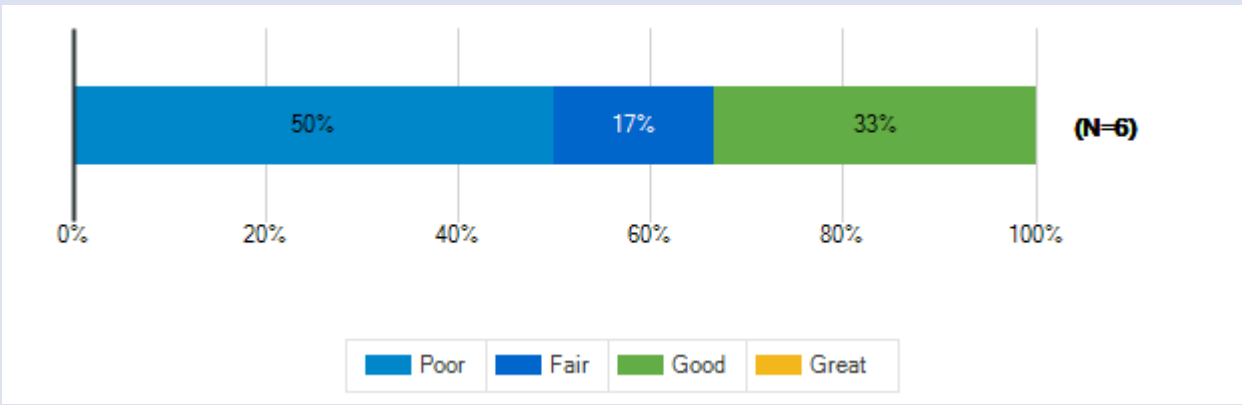
How would you describe the following characteristics of your classroom?: Electric Lighting

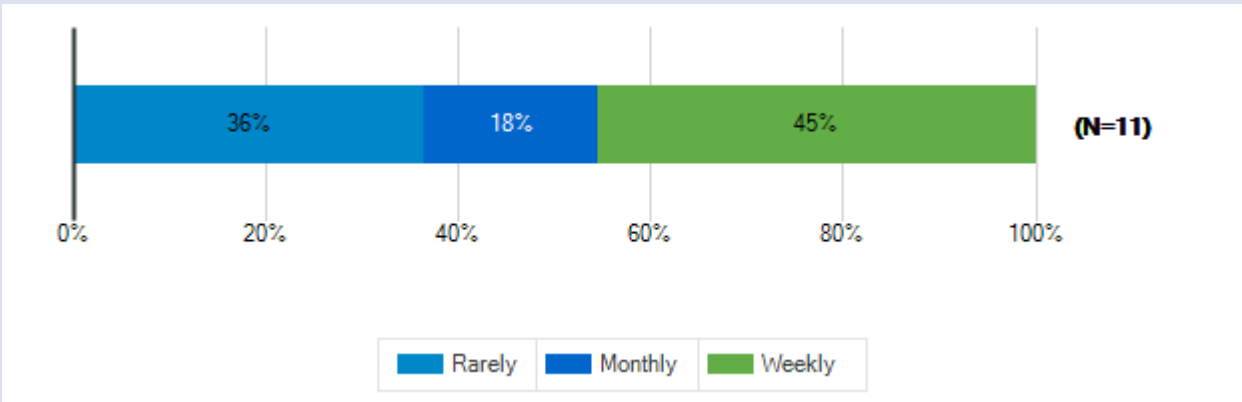

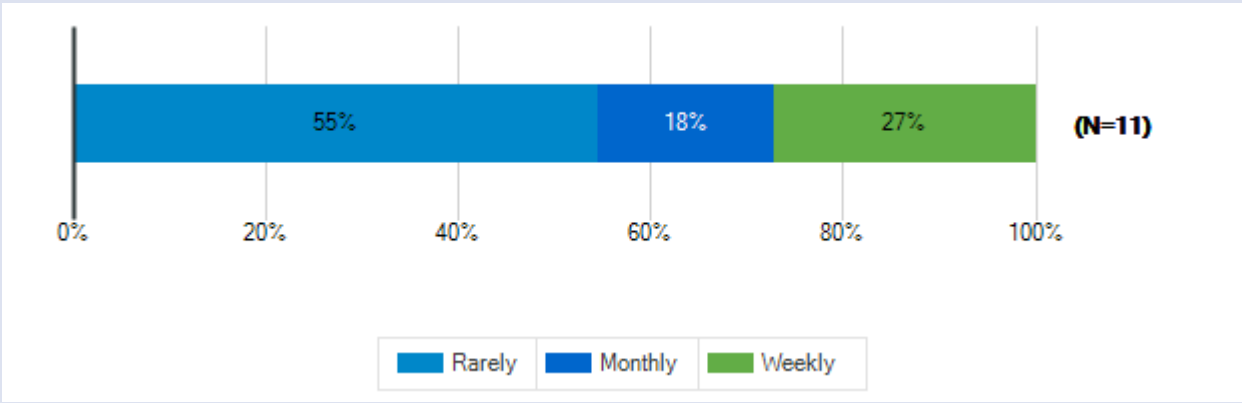
How often do you use these spaces?: Cafeteria

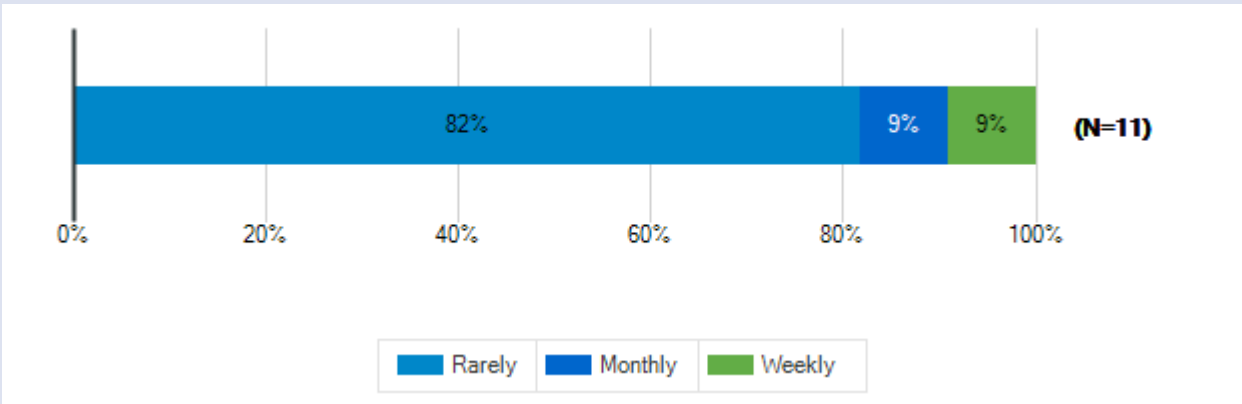

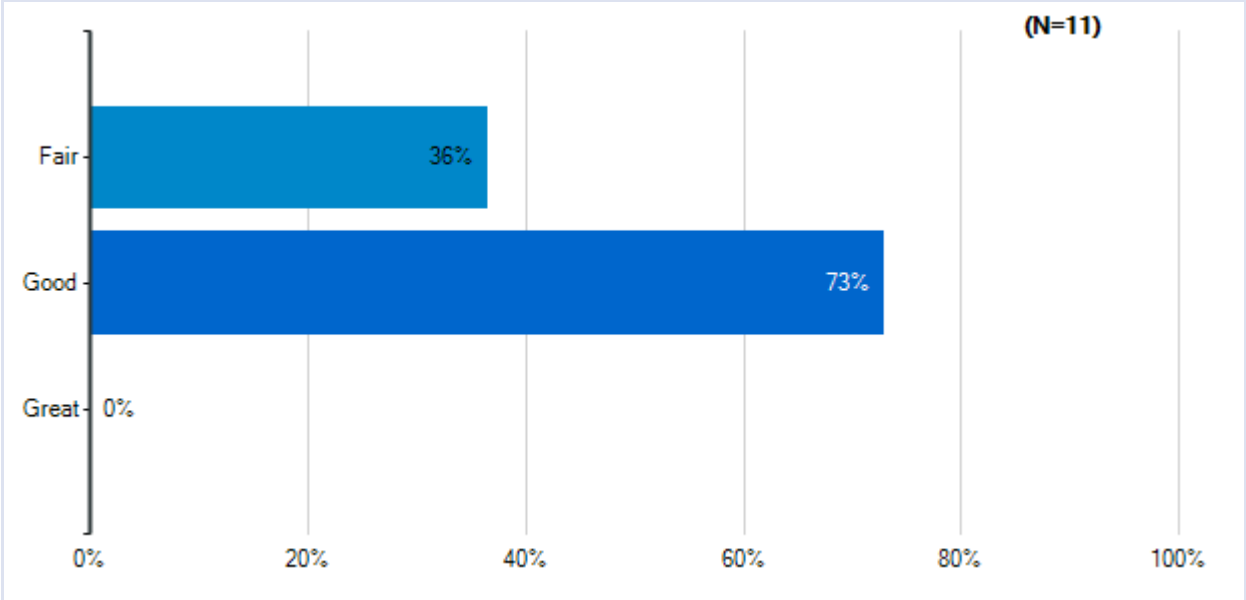

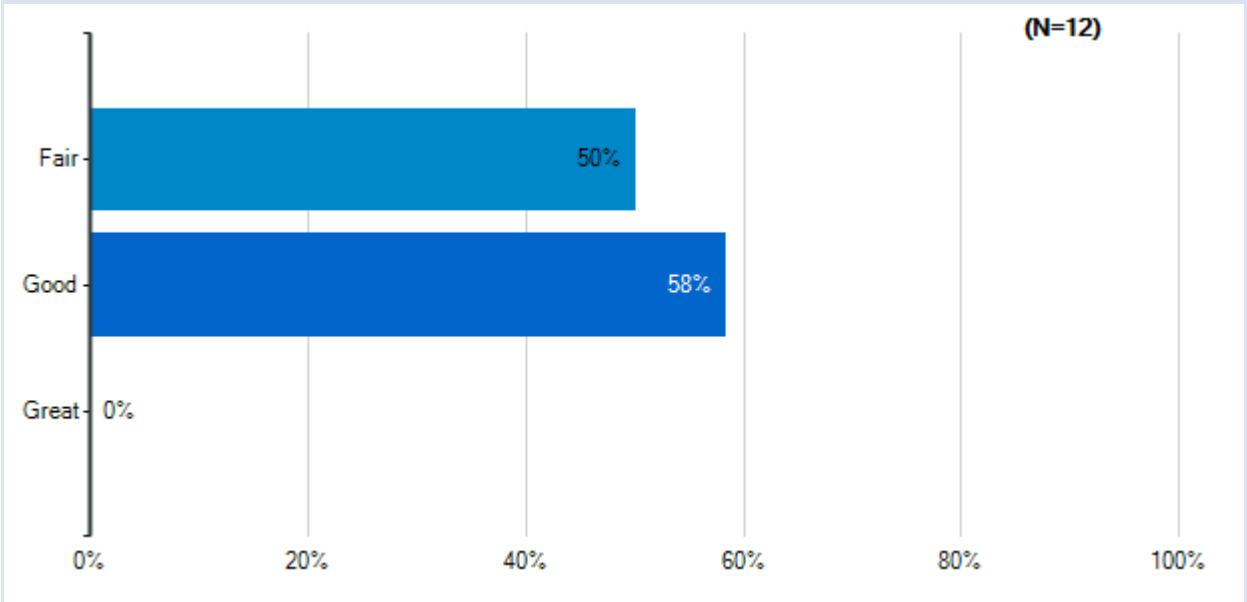

How would you rate these spaces?: Outdoor Recreation/Athletic Fields



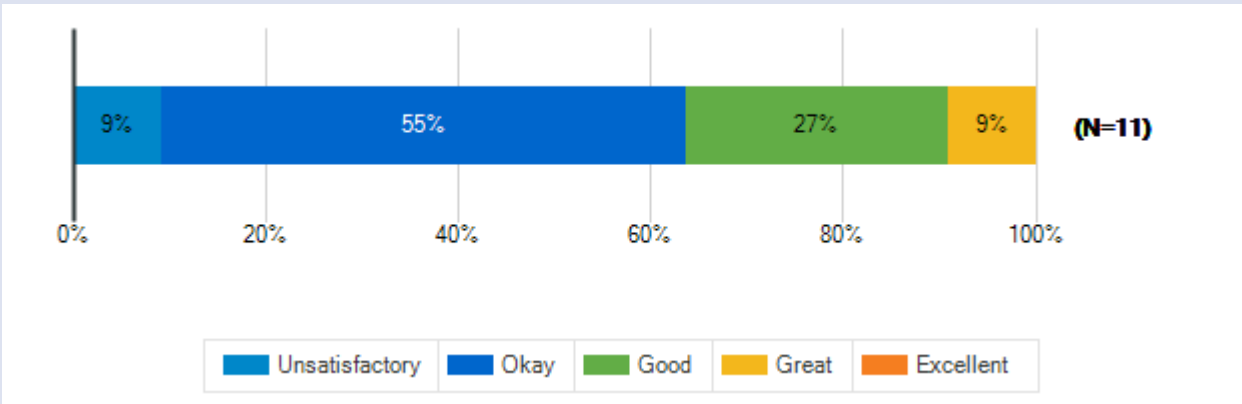

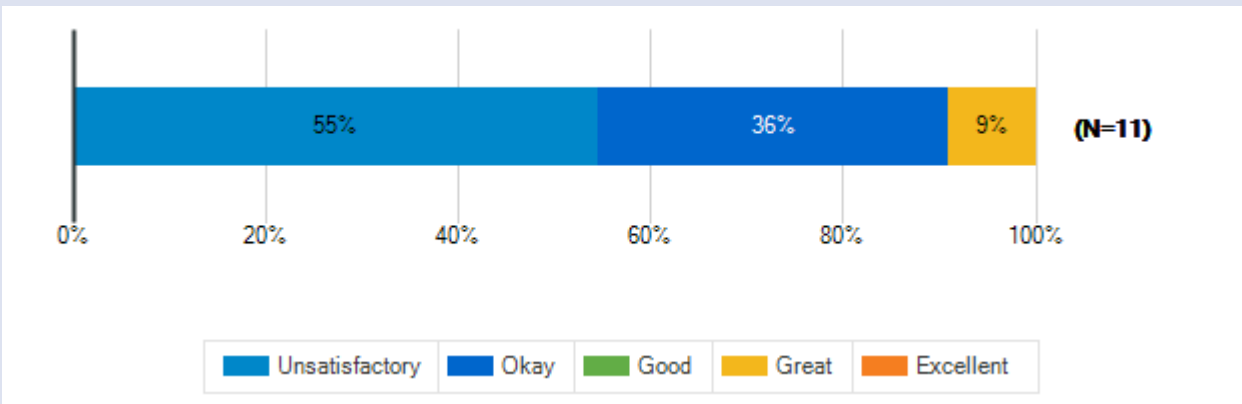

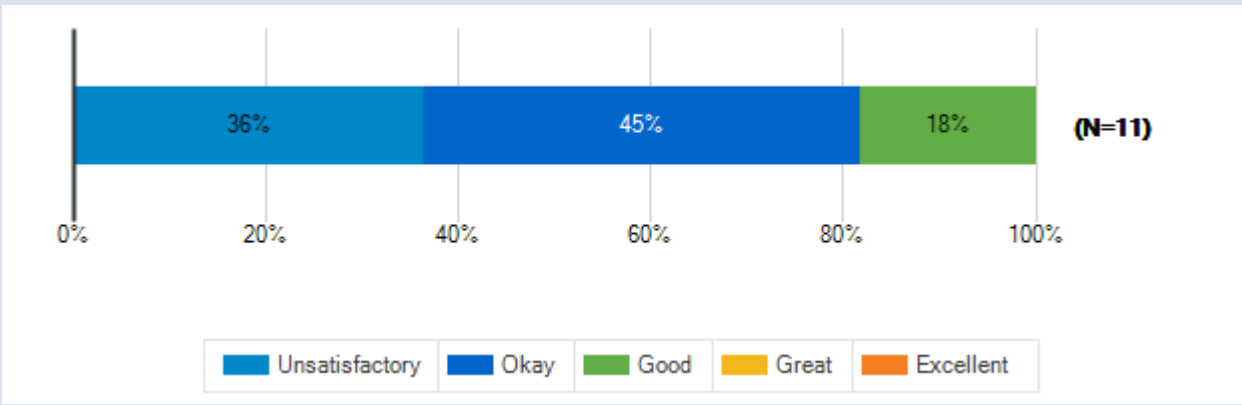
How would you rate the quality of the following characteristics of your classrooms?: Cleanliness

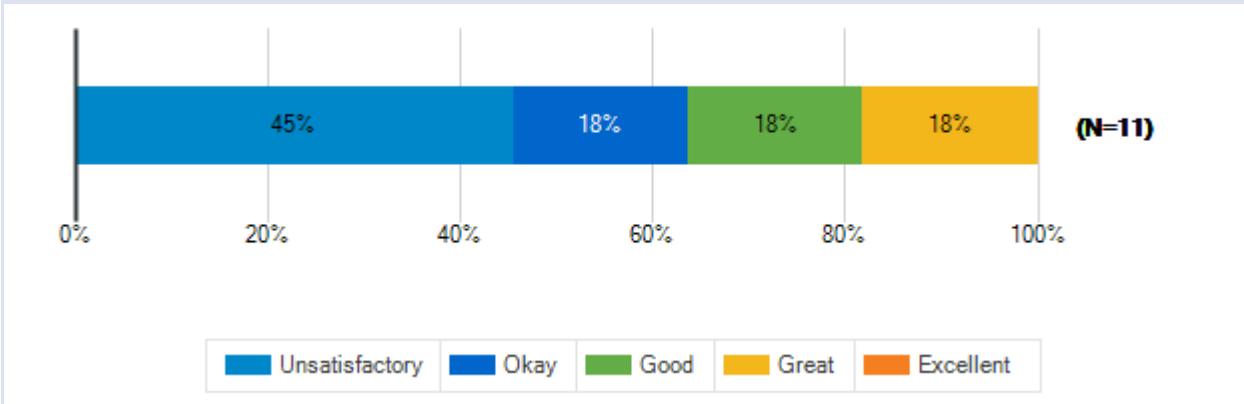

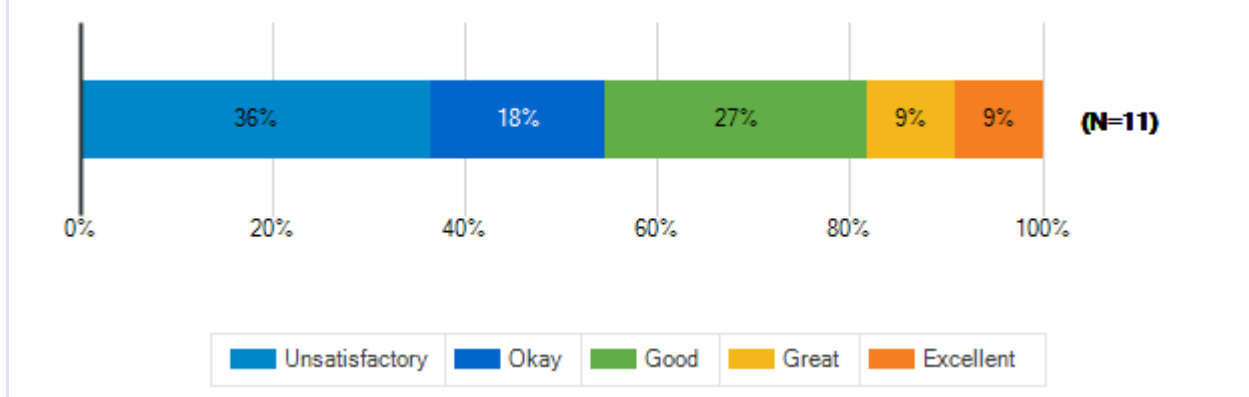

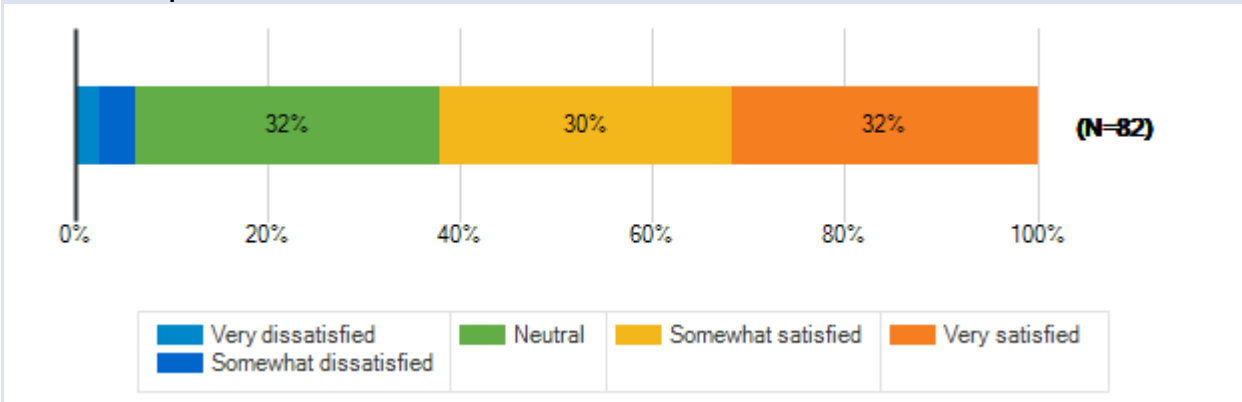

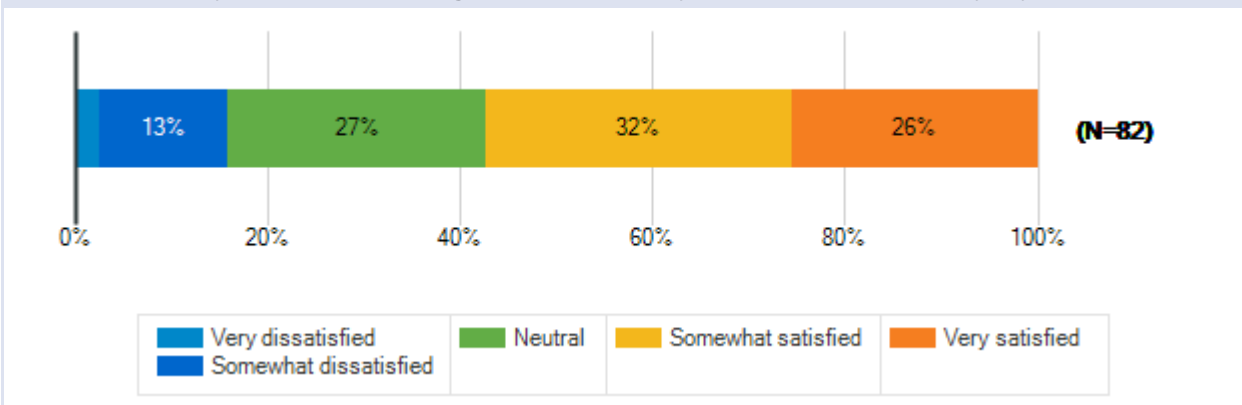
How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Design/Flow of CAR Drop-Off and Pick-Up for Students



How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Design/Flow of BUS Drop-Off and Pick-Up for Students

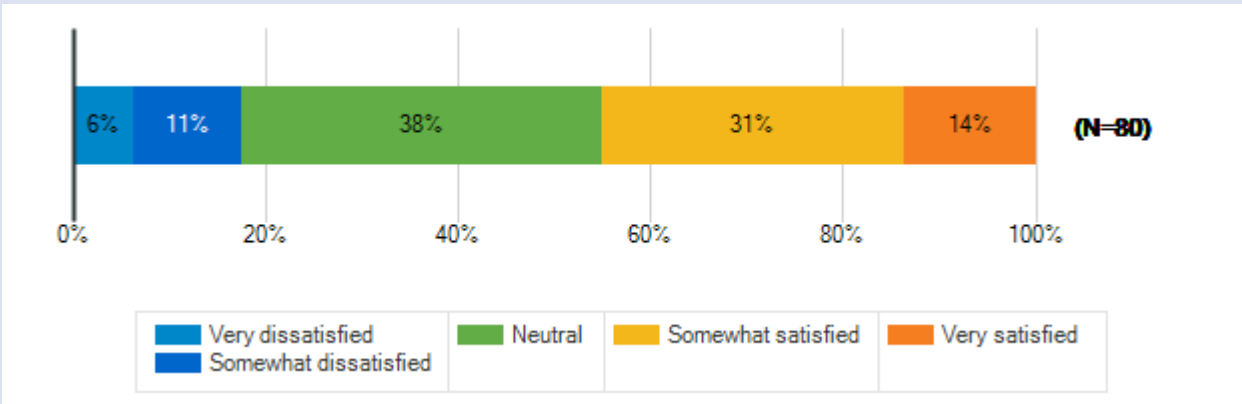


How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Entryway into the School

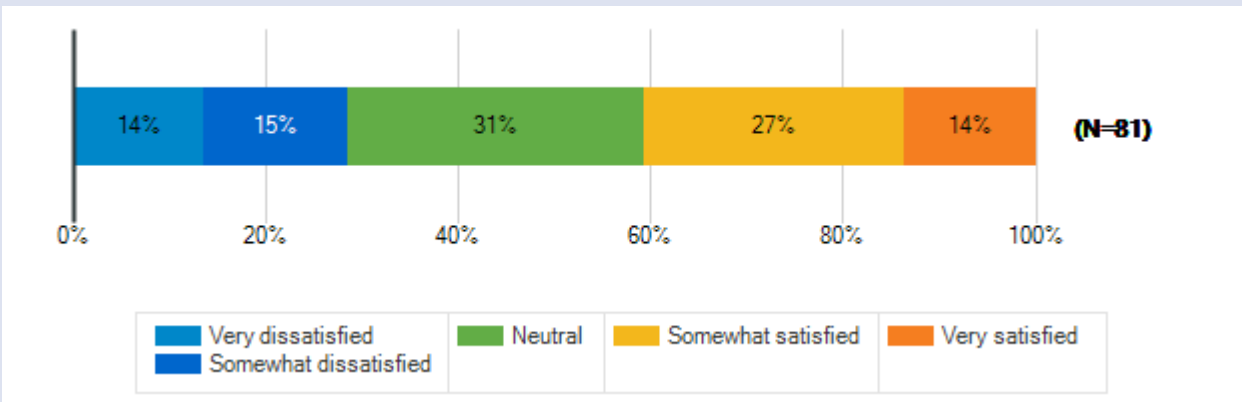

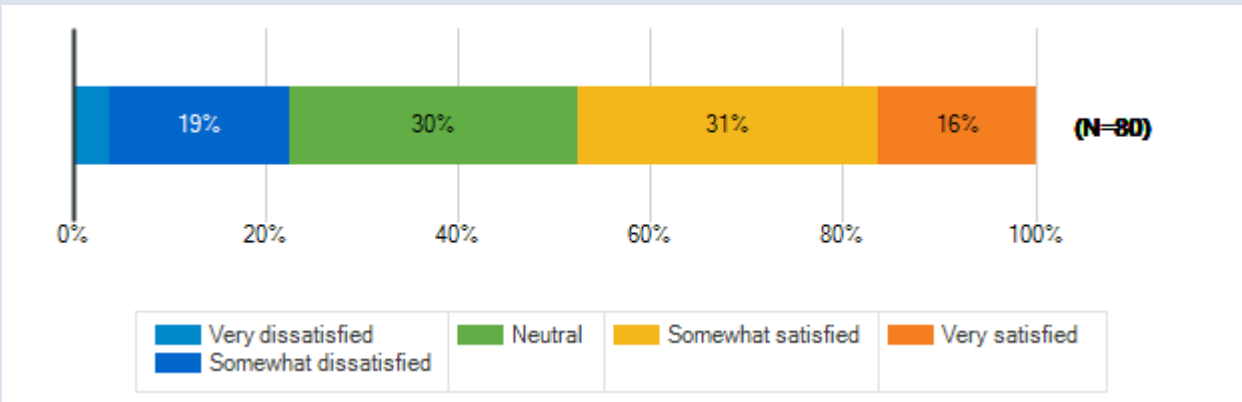
How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Classroom

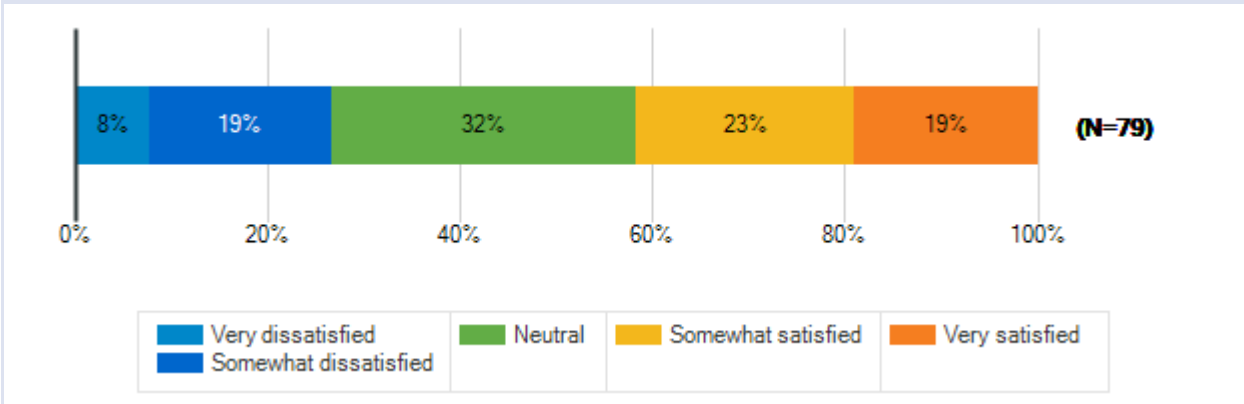


How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Technology

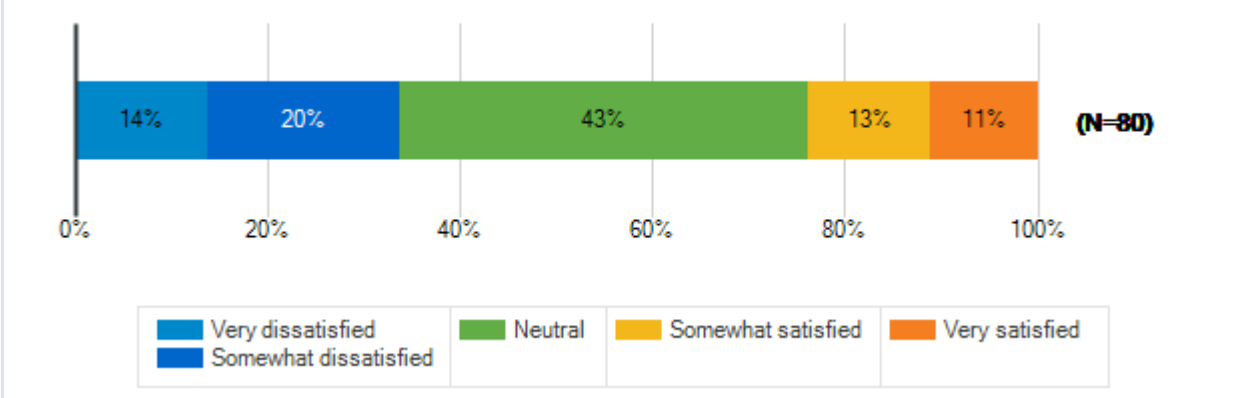

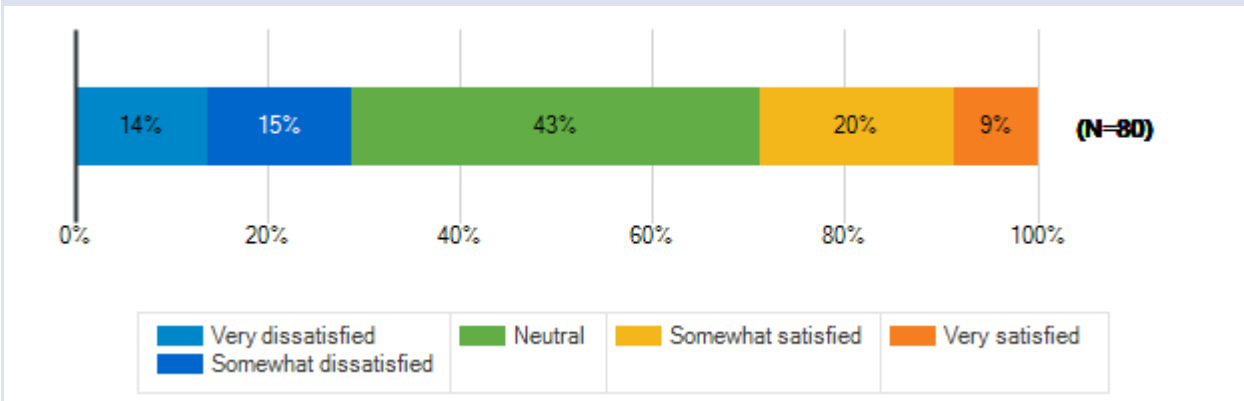
How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Learning Environment



How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Natural Lighting/Outdoor Visibility

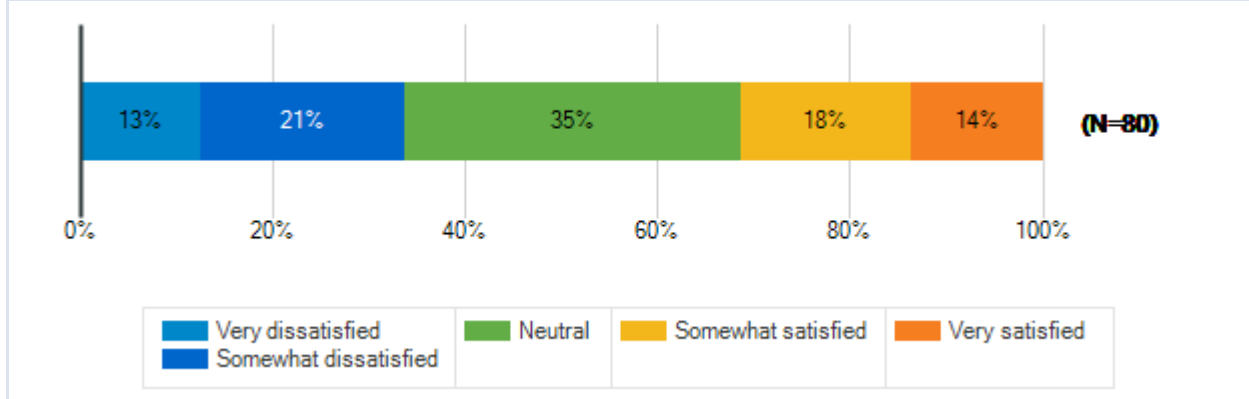


How satisfied are you with the following characteristics of your child's school?: Performance spaces

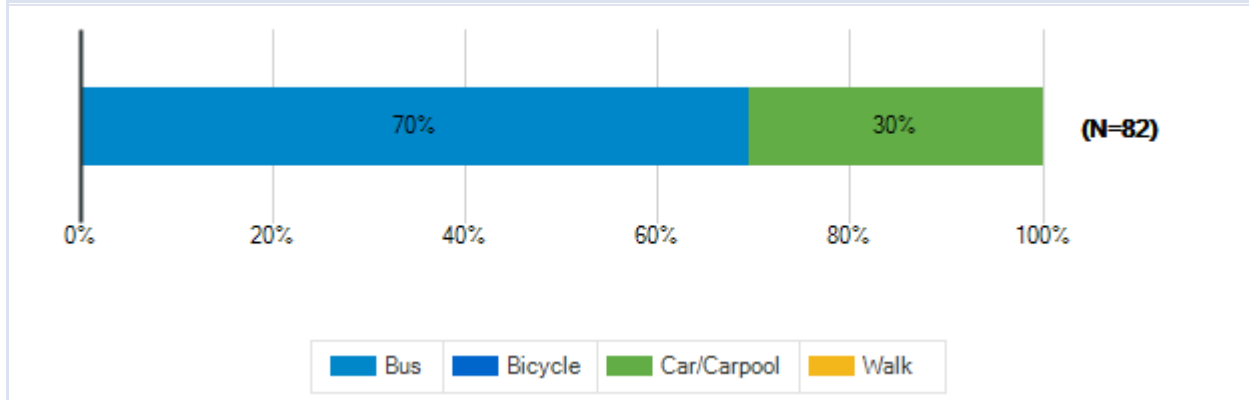

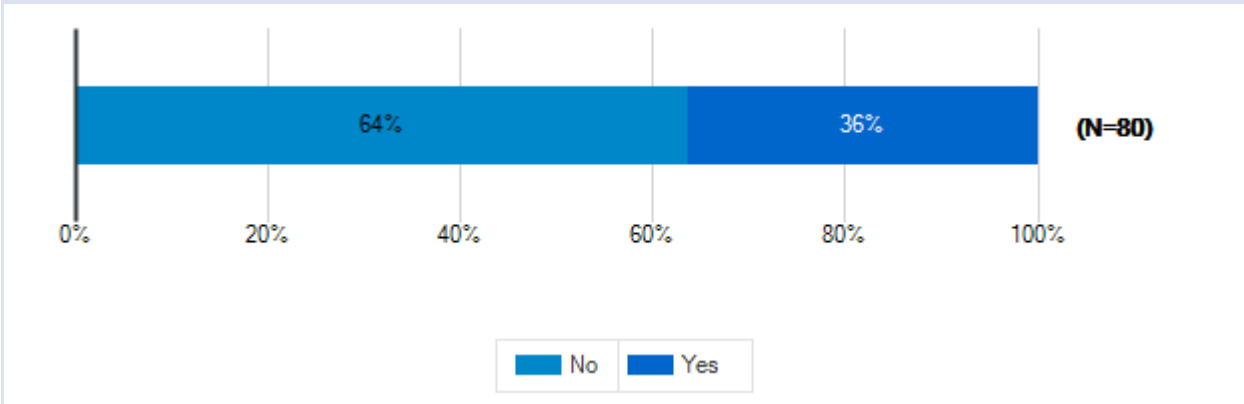
