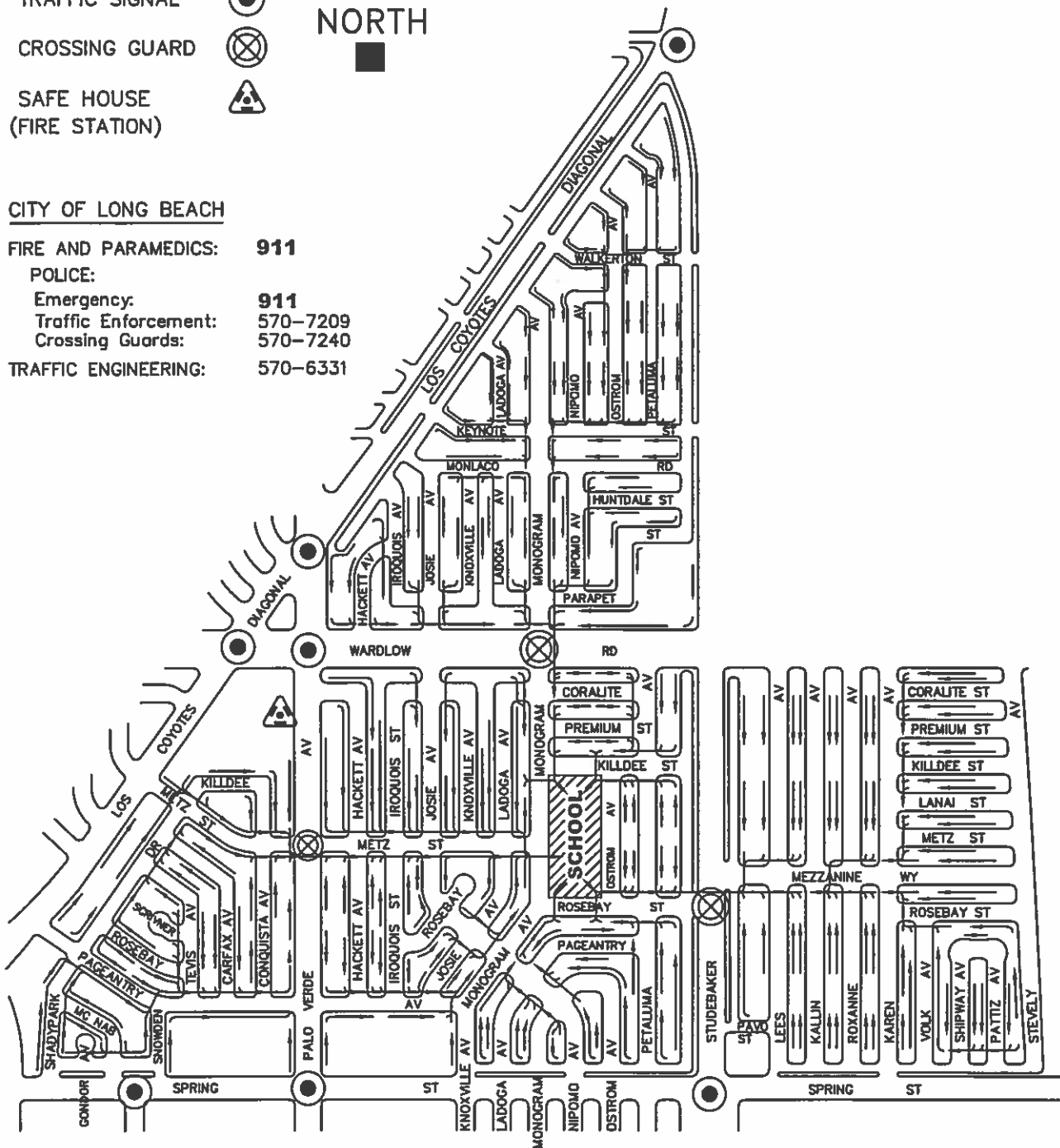

IT IS SUGGESTED THAT YOU ACTUALLY WALK OVER THE ROUTE WITH YOUR CHILD, ANSWERING ANY QUESTIONS HE OR SHE MAY HAVE CONCERNING THE MAP, POINTING OUT SUCH TRAFFIC CONTROL FEATURES AS STOP SIGNS, SIGNALS, ETC. ON HIS OR HER ROUTE TO SCHOOL.

PLEASE KEEP THIS MAP IN YOUR HOME AND GO OVER IT WITH YOUR CHILD FROM TIME TO TIME TO MAKE SURE THAT HE OR SHE KNOWS AND USES THE SCHOOL ROUTE.

SAFETY RULES

CHILDREN & PARENTS

CHILDREN:

1. STREETS ARE FOR VEHICLES – BYCYCLES AND CARS ARE VEHICLES. SKATEBOARDS AND ROLLERSKATES/ROLLERBLADES ARE NOT!
2. FOLLOW “SAFEST SCHOOL ROUTE”. OBEY ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS, SIGNALS, AND CROSSING GUARDS. WALK YOUR BIKE ACROSS INTERSECTIONS.
3. LICENSE YOUR BIKE AT THE NEAREST FIRE STATION.
4. DRIVE YOUR BIKE ON THE RIGHT. LEARN AND OBEY BICYCLE TRAFFIC LAWS. LOCK YOUR BIKE WHEN NOT IN USE.
5. DO NOT RIDE SKATEBOARDS OR ROLLERSKATES TO SCHOOL.
6. AT A BUS STOP, DO NOT PLAY WHILE WAITING FOR A BUS AND STAND IN AN ORDERLY LINE.

PARENTS OR GUARDIANS

1. PARENTS AND ADULTS SET EXAMPLES FOR CHILDREN – MAKE YOURS GOOD ONES!
2. NEVER DOUBLE PARK YOUR CAR. PARK ONLY WHERE PERMITTED.
3. USE SEAT BELTS FOR SAFETY. PROVIDE THEM FOR YOUR CHILDREN'S SAFETY.
4. ALWAYS KNOW WHERE YOUR CHILD IS WHEN HE OR SHE IS NOT IN SCHOOL OR AT HOME.
5. TEACH YOUR CHILD:
 - A. To cross only on a new green light or “WALK” indicator at a signalized intersection. If pedestrian push button is available, press button once to change light.
 - B. Never talk to, go near, or get into a car with a stranger.
 - C. Never take candy, presents, or money from a stranger, or allow them to touch him, walk with him, or fuss with his clothes.
 - D. To walk to and from school with a classmate or friend living near you.
 - E. To “YELL FOR HELP” when frightened. Run to the home of a block parent or Safe House (Fire Station).
6. PROHIBIT THE USE OF BICYCLES ON RAINY OR FOGGY SCHOOL DAYS.
7. WHEN VISIBILITY IS POOR IN FOGGY, STORMY WEATHER, ACCOMPANY YOUR CHILD TO AND FROM SCHOOL.
8. ACCOMPANY YOUR CHILD CROSSING THE STREEET TO GET TO YOUR CAR OR SCHOOL OTHER THAN AT AN INTERSECTION.
