



NIS Grades 9-12 Supply List

Organization System:

Students in grades 9-12 are expected to keep their work organized either through the use of an online system such as Google drive or binders (to keep chronological order of class handouts), and notebooks (to record class notes, homework and journal writing). Students may choose their own A4 binder/notebook style.

Required for all students:

- Laptop
- A4 binders with loose lined paper OR A4 lined notebooks (one for each class)
- Square or graph paper – loose (5mm grid) for home use only
- Graphical Display Calculator (GDC) - (NIS recommends Texas Instruments TI-83 or 84)
 - Grade 9: GDC recommended for high school and longer use
 - Grade 10: GDC highly recommended in preparation for Grade 11-12
 - Grade 11+: GDC required
- Pencil case with: pens, pencils, erasers, ruler, scissors, glue stick
- Coloured pencils or highlighters
- Athletic wear for Physical Education (Grades 9-10)
- Combination lock for locker
- Water bottle

Additional Information:

- Planner: to help students stay organized. The planner can be either a physical or digital. Your child is responsible for using their planner and recording all assignments.
- Laptop: students in grades 9-12 must bring their own. fully charged laptop to school. - Locker: each student will be assigned a locker by their homeroom teacher at the start of the year. Lockers do not come with locks, but students must lock their locker.
- There is no uniform for Physical Education classes. However, students must change into athletic wear (t-shirts, sweatpants, etc. - no jeans allowed) before class begins. Non-marking athletic shoes must be worn in the gym (no black soles). Students participating in school sports will be provided team uniform, so there is no need to purchase.
- All required items can be purchased at local department stores (Apita, AEON) or at 100 yen stores (Daiso, Seria).
- Locks can also be purchased from the school.
