**Molly Blum, First Grade Teacher, Fort Mill Elementary:** Ms. Blum received a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood and Elementary Education from Winthrop University. Additionally, she completed coursework for the Early Literacy Assessment and Instruction Certifications at Clemson University. Ms. Blum has participated in numerous leadership and training activities for future teachers, including the Ci3t Leadership Team Training and Implementation and the SERRRA Conference for Early Literacy and Reading Recovery.

**Dani Cancro, Special Education Teacher, Sugar Creek Elementary:** Ms. Cancro is a graduate of Stellenbosch University in South Africa with a degree in Education. She's also received a Master's Degree in Special Education from Long Island University and a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Winthrop University. Her leadership experiences include serving as a Special Education Lead Trainer, and she coaches the Sugar Creek Elementary School Striders Club.

**Robin Orlick, Art Teacher, Doby's Bridge Elementary:** Ms. Orlick graduated from the University of South Carolina with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Art Education, a Master of Arts, and a Master of Educational Leadership, both from Winthrop University. She is a member of the South Carolina Art Education Association and the National Art Education Association. In addition, she serves as the Related Arts Team Leader and as a mentor teacher at Doby's Bridge.

**Kasey Segal, Second Grade, Springfield Elementary:** Ms. Segal earned a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education from Georgia College and State University and a Master of Education in Teaching in Learning with an emphasis in Instructional Coaching from Clemson University. She serves as the team lead for her grade level, facilitating professional learning team meetings.
