Nearly 80% of girls' school students report most of their classes challenge them to achieve their full academic potential compared to 72.3% of girls at coed independent schools and 44.3% at coed public schools.

Nearly 50% of all women graduating from girls' schools rate their public speaking ability as high, compared to 38% from coed schools. Over 64% of girls' school graduates assess their writing ability as high, compared to 58% from coed schools.
