

## Classroom managed behaviors: Minor problem behavior definitions

Defiance: Student engages in brief or low-intensity failure to follow directions or talks back

<u>Classroom disruption</u>: Student engages in low-intensity, but inappropriate disruption

Dress code: Student wears clothing that is near, but not within, the dress code guidelines defined by the school/district.

Disrespect: Student delivers low-intensity, socially rude or dismissive messages to adults or students

<u>Technology violation</u>: Student engages in non-serious, but inappropriate (as defined by school) use of cell phone, pager, music/video players, camera, and/or computer.

Inappropriate language: Student engages in low-intensity instance of inappropriate language.

PDA: Student engages in non-serious, but inappropriate physical contact. Student engages in inappropriate, consensual (as

defined by school) verbal and/or physical gestures/contact, of a sexual nature to another student/adult.

<u>Cheating</u>: Student delivers message that is untrue and/or deliberately violates rules.

<u>Avoidance of tasks(refusing to work)</u>: Student engages in problem behaviors(s) to get away/escape from tasks and/or activities.

## Office Managed: Major Problem Behavior Definitions

Defiance/disrespect: Student delivers socially rude or dismissive messages to adults or students.

<u>Weapons</u>: Student is in possession of knives (> 6 in., < 6 in.) and guns (real or look alike), or other objects readily capable of causing bodily harm.

<u>Fighting/Aggressive behavior</u>: Student engages in actions involving serious physical contact where injury may occur (e.g., hitting, punching, hitting with an object, kicking, hair pulling, scratching, etc.).

<u>Aggressive Language:</u> Student delivers verbal messages that include swearing, name calling, or use of words in an inappropriate way.

<u>Harassment/Intimidation of student or staff</u>: The delivery of disrespectful messages in any format related to gender, ethnicity, sex, race, religion, disability, physical features, or other protected class.

<u>Truancy/skipping class/leaving school grounds</u>: Student is late (as defined by the school) to class or the start up of the school day (and Tardy is not considered a minor problem behavior in the school). Student receives an 'unexcused absence' for ½ day or more. Student leaves or misses class without permission

<u>Technical/electronic/AUP violations:</u> Student engages in inappropriate (as defined by school) use of cell phone, pager, music/video players, camera, and/or computer.

<u>Smoking/alcohol/drugs</u>:Student is in possession of or is using alcohol. Student is in possession of or is using illegal drugs/substances or imitations. Student is in possession of or is using tobacco.

<u>Vandalism</u>: Student participates in an activity that results in destruction or disfigurement of property.

<u>Dress code</u>: Student wears clothing that does not fit within the dress code guidelines practiced by the school/district. <u>Excessive PDA</u>:Student engages in inappropriate, consensual (as defined by school) verbal and/or physical gestures/contact, of a sexual nature to another student/adult.
