KEY TAKEAWAYS

Our board meeting agendas often include many items for discussion. While you will always be able to review the agenda, meeting minutes and video recordings of these meetings on [our Board webpage](#), this Board Bulletin provides key takeaways for our Stevenson community.

- 1** At Monday's meeting, the Board of Education voted to approve the 2023-2024 Student Guidebook, a guiding document that outlines policies and expectations for student conduct. The guidebook is an annual collaborative effort between faculty, parents and deans.
- 2** The Board also voted unanimously to renew the school's contract for athletic training, strength training, and physical therapy services through Rebound Fitness. The ability to offer in-house services through Rebound, which bills insurance directly for services not provided by the school, has been immensely beneficial to both students and staff. Patriots may schedule time to see a member of the Rebound team without missing instructional time.
- 3** Lastly, the Board voted to make available for public viewing the tentative 2023-24 budget. The tentative budget will be posted on the Stevenson website beginning June 30, with a public hearing to follow at the August 21 Board of Education meeting. It will also be available to see in the District Office.
