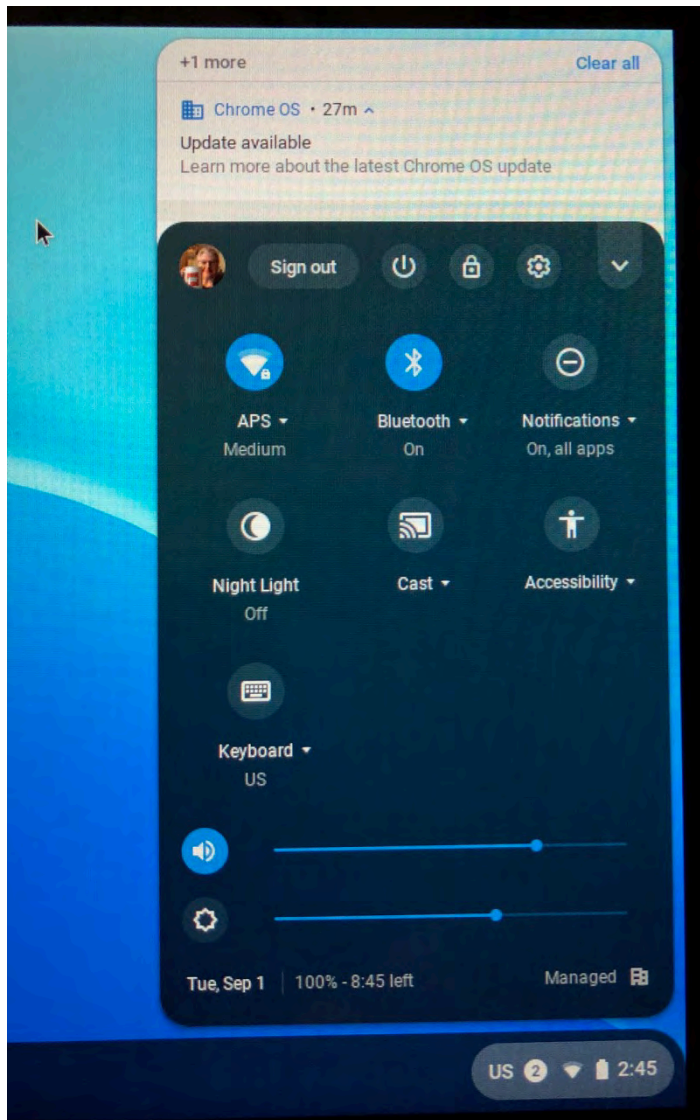
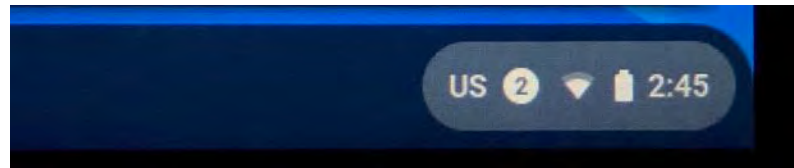


Checking for Updates on an APS Chromebook

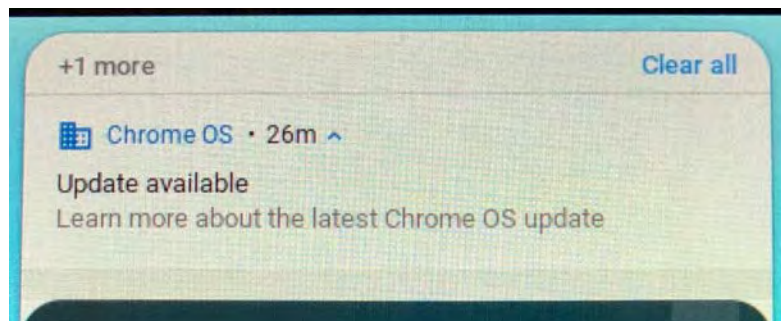
When you are logged into your Chromebook, click on the **Control Center** button in the lower right corner of the screen.

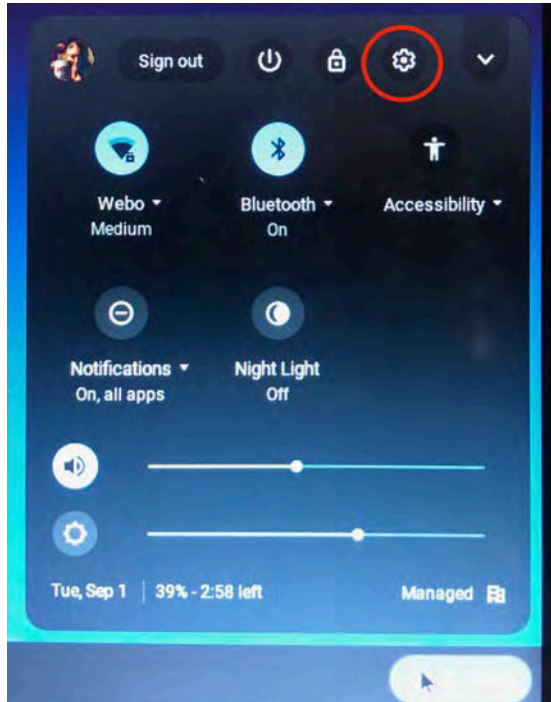


The **Control Center** will pop up. If there is an update ready, a message about it should appear above the Control Center. (You may need to click on “+1 more” or even “+2 more” in order to see all your messages.)

Sometimes the message will tell you to **re-start your computer** in order for the update to finish.

Sometimes you will need to click on the message (the blue title) to get further instructions.

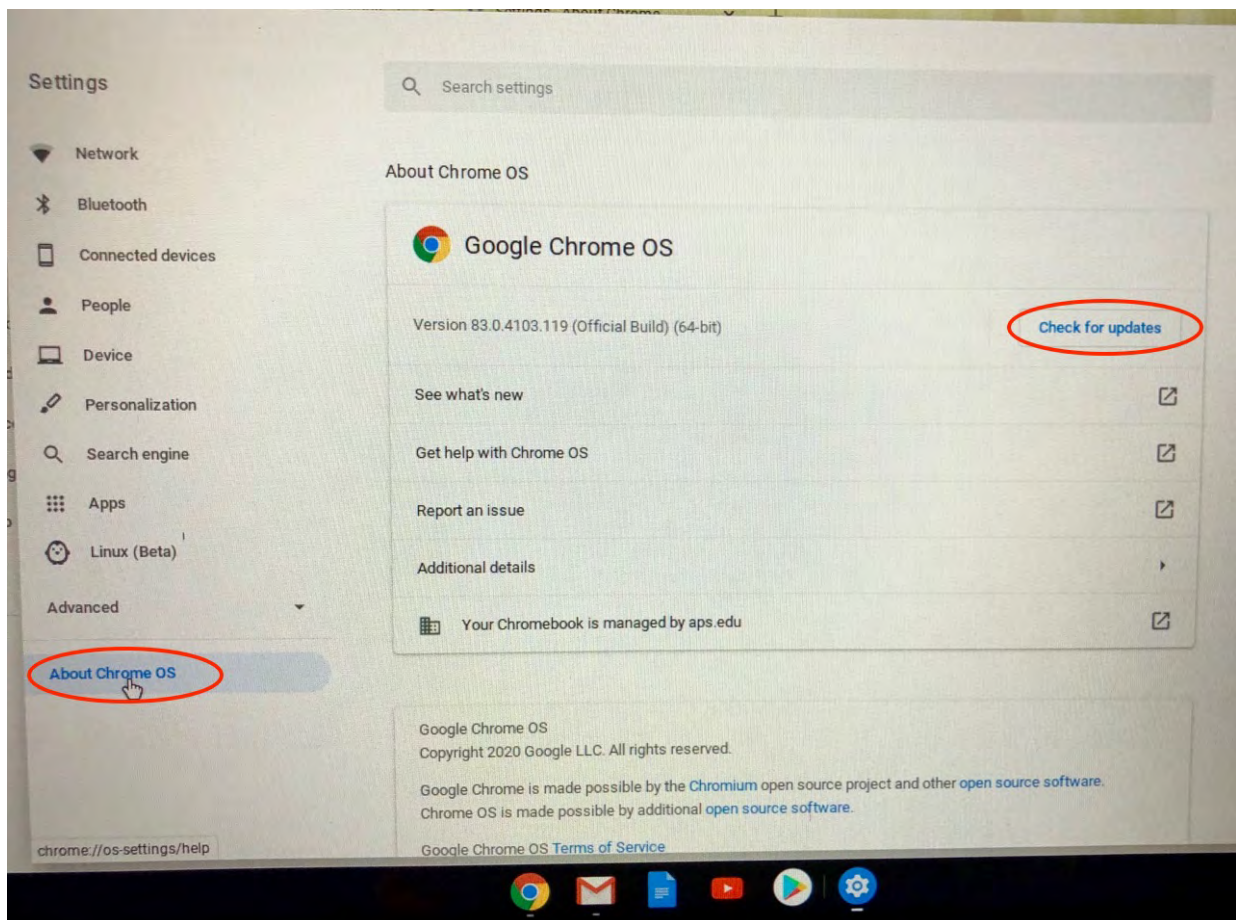




If there is no message, you can check MANUALLY for an update.

Click on the **Settings** icon – it looks like a gear.

When the Settings window opens, select “**About Chrome OS**” from the left-hand navigation column. If you see a button labeled “**Check for Updates**”, click on that button.



Restart to finish the update.
