Treasurer Report - Amanda Dougherty

- Account Balance: \$46,359.95
- Remaining Budgeted Expenses: Approx \$7500
 - Summary of Staff Grants - \$6,715
 - \$4,890 in grants paid out to 52 staff members with most getting the full \$100.
 - books, pockets, dividers, carts, manipulatives, counseling supports, speech therapy supports, fine motor activities, magnetic letters and numbers, STEM toys, sand trays, magnetic bingo, tables, wooden train sets, dry erase writing tablets, scoop seats, building blocks, whisper phones, craft supplies, CVC and phonetic tools, bins, Teachers Pay Teachers templates, Autism Helper templates, etc.
 - This new method of accepting photos of receipts has been much more effective in getting the funds into the hands of the teachers.
