When placement is not clear, a teacher’s professional judgment based on their classroom contact with a student over several months should be used for making recommendations. No subjective recommendations are used to change a student’s placement to a lower math course than performance data indicates.

Students will be assessed at least once during the first month of 9<sup>th</sup> grade to ensure accurate placement in their Mathematics course.

A parent or student may appeal math placement by contacting the student’s counselor.
