

DreamBox FAQ

Is it okay to help my student with their lessons?

- It is very important for students to work independently to play DreamBox. The program is adaptive, so help from an adult, sibling, etc. will alter the students' performance and what the program is giving the students for their "just right" level. DreamBox has help tools and hints embedded in the program, so if your student is struggling, encourage them to look for those tools. Wrong answers will also help them learn and allow the program to adapt to their needs.

Which devices can I use to play DreamBox?

- Students can play DreamBox on all computers, laptops, and Chromebooks through an internet browser and on all iPad tablets since iPad 2 (2011) through our DreamBox Math apps. At this time, DreamBox is not available on smartphones and is not supported on Android tablets.

How do I log in?

- All students have the ability to log in using their Groton email address. However, younger students may also have been given a QR code from their teachers for ease in logging in. Students are familiar with the login process from school, but see below for directions.

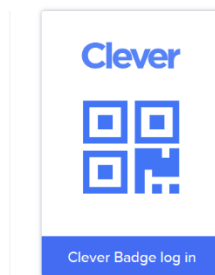
- Go to www.clever.com
- Click **Log in as a student**
- If you are using your **school issued Google email account** to log in...
 - Search for your school (Groton Public Schools)

- Click Log in with Google
 - Older students will be able to do this without help, while younger students may need help.
 - The username is their first name, middle initial, and the first four letters from their last name. (So Lucky W. Eastwood would be luckyweast@grotonk12.org.)
 - Make sure the address is @grotonk12.org.
 - Click "Next"
 - Have your child enter the password - "groton." Click "Next."
 - Click on the "DreamBox" icon. Now your child is logged in and can play DreamBox!
- If you are using a **QR code** issued by the school (younger students only)...
 - Click **Clever Badge log in**
 - Your computer may ask permission to access the camera. Click on "Allow."
 - Your camera will turn on. Hold up the QR Code until a green check appears on the screen.
 - Click on the "DreamBox" icon. Now your child is logged in and can play DreamBox!
