The coach will be responsible for conducting practices on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 4:30pm - 5:30pm, with games scheduled after school. Candidates must attend an orientation meeting, and fulfill all Athletics Department certifications, including CPR/First Aid, concussion training, and mental health training.
