Be sure to have your child's FIRST and LAST name and the grade they are entering visible on the cover of their paper or digital file.

Students who return Summer Math notebooks or folders to their new teachers or the Director of Mathematics will receive recognition and an award from the Mathematics Department if they turn in completed work for *at least* **24 days**.
