## Jody D'Addario Trumbull Public Schools Teacher of the Year 2024

Jody D'Addario has served Trumbull Public Schools for 27 years. Currently an 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science teacher and team leader at Madison Middle School, D'Addario believes that "Each student has a unique approach to solving problems," and that giving her students a chance for their "revelations to expand, grow, and shape existing background knowledge... [allows] students to learn from collective past knowledge and apply new knowledge and skills to future problems..."

As one Madison teacher shared, "She is passionate about Science and is able to communicate this passion to her students. Jody genuinely works at making her classroom a place where learning is fun and exciting, so as to get the best out of her students." She expanded "Although she may not agree with students all of the time, she keeps an open

"It makes [the students] appreciate their own lives when they learn about the lives of others with far more challenging circumstances."
