Proposition 28 Update: Mrs. Ondrea Reed, Deputy Superintendent

Deputy Superintendent Reed provided the Board and the community with an update on what the District currently knows about Prop 28, which provides additional funding for arts education in public schools. Mrs. Reed explained that there are still quite a few unknowns, including the exact dollar amount, when funds will arrive and the reporting mechanism, regarding Prop 28 however the District plans to submit a Phase 1 plan for schools to receive their 20 percent of the funds to be spent on arts supplies and materials.


**Board President's Report: Mr. Chris Forehan**

- Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP): Mrs. Melissa Davis, Director of Assessment
  - Mrs. Davis presented a draft of actions and goals that are in the District's LCAP for the 2023-24 school year. She also provided a brief overview of the stakeholder engagement process. A draft of the LCAP can be viewed on the district website by clicking the following link: 2023-24 Draft LCAP
  - The Board will adopt the final 2023-24 LCAP at the June 27, 2023 Board of Education meeting.
- Proposed Los Alamitos Unified School District Annual Budget for the 2023-24 Fiscal Year: Ms. Elvia Galicia, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services
  - During her presentation, Ms. Galicia provided an overview of the 2023-24 Governor's May Budget Revision and Fiscal Outlook, which is what the District uses to base the budget on.
  - She noted that school districts in California are required by statute to adopt an annual budget by July 1 even though the State's budget, by which K-12 public education is funded, may not be finalized by that date.
  - The Board will adopt the final proposed budget at the June 27, 2023 Board of Education meeting.
