#### a. Update on Curriculum Database - Rubicon Atlas

**Minutes**

Dr. Winslow gave an update on the Curriculum Database: Rubicon Atlas. A small group consisting of Stacy, Traci Landry and Dave Sweigert, met with the vendor on Wednesday, November 4th, and were very impressed with the product. This product will enable us to use the web-based management system. This product is completely customizable. We will be able to use the templates that we already have in place. Arrangements have been made for a web meeting with the Curriculum Coordinators on November 19th. This will be approximately one hour. An email was sent to coordinators to try to be in attendance to give their input, and their voice to see if this is a usable system as they will be the on the ground users of the system. The pricing for this product will be a phase in somewhere between 75 to 100 licenses for the Spring to pilot it. The cost will be a little more than \$2,000. We are very happy with the phase in opportunity to get use to it instead of rolling it out all at one time. We want to make sure this is a system that is good, usable and appropriate for our needs.

**a. HS FCS - 9th Grade Culinary Arts**

**Minutes**

**a. Course Addition: Sequence of German Courses**

Continue the sequence of German courses at the High School. German II would be added in 2016-2017; German III in 2017-2018; German IV in 2018-2019.

**Minutes**

Dr. Reimann gave an overview on the Sequence of German Courses. This proposal continues with the proposed German I from February of last year. Textbooks were retained from the previous years where German was incorporated in our curriculum. German I was put before the full board. We are asking for the sequence to be brought back for approval. A suggestion was to add the chart of sequence specifying the years each course will be offered to the High School course selection booklet. This will make students aware of the sequence at a glance. A motion to accept this first read was made by Heidi Eby and seconded by Chris Barrett. All were in favor and the proposal was approved for a first read.

**b. Course Addition: AP Studio Art: 3-D Design and AP Studio Art: Drawing**

Add two courses to our Art offerings in 2016-2017: (1) AP Studio Art: 3-D Design and (2) AP Studio Art: Drawing officially to our curriculum.

**Minutes**

Naomi Brought presented a proposal for a first read to add AP Studio Art: 3-D Design into the 2016-2017 curriculum. A motion to accept this first read was made by Brian Shiflett and seconded by Heidi Eby. All were in favor and the proposal was approved for a first read.

**c. Course Addition: Advanced Physical Education**

This course is open to any 11th and 12th grade student who is interested in learning about advanced physical education topics. Students completing this course will have an excellent background in sports leadership, fitness program development, sports management, recreation and coaching. This course will also benefit students interested in majoring in health/physical education, sports management, coaching, and athletic administration.
