



# International School of Hellerup (ISH) School Fees for the 2023-2024 Academic Year

The International School of Hellerup is a not-for-profit educational institution operating under Danish law and receiving financial support from the Danish State. However, to cover our operational expenses, we rely on monthly school fees. Please find below important information regarding the fees and related policies for the 2023-2024 academic year.

## **Important Notice for New Families: School Fee Subsidies and CPR/CDR Registration**

To qualify for subsidised school fees, your child's CPR/CDR number must be registered with the municipality where you reside by September 1st. Please provide the number and registered address (as stated on the yellow Health Insurance Card, "Sundhedskort") to our Admission Officer at [admissions@ish.dk](mailto:admissions@ish.dk) by September 1st. Failure to provide the CPR/CDR number will result in non-subsidised fees being charged, as the school cannot receive a state subsidy for your child.

Please be aware that the programme fee is applicable for the entire year, including the month of July. This applies to all families, including those who have declined re-enrollment for the upcoming school year. In the event of a family choosing to withdraw during the re-enrollment period, the July fees will be charged.

## Whole School Fees

### Admissions Fee

We require a non-refundable admissions fee of DKK 2,000 per child at the time of application.

### School Deposit Fee

A one-time refundable deposit is payable for all students upon acceptance at the International School of Hellerup, as per the following schedule:

Child 1: DKK 8,000

Child 2: DKK 7,000 (total deposit fee for two children at ISH is DKK 15,000)

Child 3: DKK 4,500,- (total deposit fee for three or more children at ISH is DKK 19,500)

Child 4 and up: no additional deposit

*Please refer to the Withdrawal Policy and Re-Enrollment sections for terms and conditions regarding the refund of the school deposit.*

### LSS (Learning Support Services)

Learning Support Services (LSS) are available to students who require additional assistance to meet curriculum standards. Access to LSS is granted after an evaluation process. The cost of LSS varies depending on the level of support needed.

For students requiring moderate support, the fee for LSS starts at DKK 3,000 per month. If your child requires intensive support with additional resources, the fee will be determined based on the specific agreement with the learning support department.

Please be aware that the LSS fee is applicable for all twelve months of the year, including July. If you decide not to re-enroll for the upcoming school year, the July fee will be charged.

### PTA Fee

Families are required to pay an annual Parent Teacher Association (PTA) fee of DKK 250 per family. This fee directly contributes to supporting PTA initiatives and events held throughout the year. It is automatically deducted in September for the entire school year. For families enrolling their child(ren) during the academic year, the PTA fee will be charged when their child starts school.

### Materials Fee

A Materials Fee of DKK 400 per child is charged annually for students in all grades. This fee covers the cost of materials and resources needed for educational activities. The Materials Fee is deducted at the beginning of each school year in August. For families enrolling their child(ren) during the academic year, the Materials Fee will be charged when their child starts school.

## Administration Fee

It is mandatory to sign up for Direct Debit (PBS Betalingservice). Detailed information on how to set up direct debit can be found on the school website: <https://ib.ish.dk/admissions/tuition-fees>. If PBS is not automatically activated within 3 months, an additional charge of DKK 500 per month will be added to the regular school fees. For assistance, contact the school at 70 20 63 68 or inquire at the school reception.

## Lunch Fee (Optional for students from Kindergarten to DP2)

A lunch service is available for all students from Pre-Kindergarten to DP2. Please note that the lunch service is mandatory for students in Pre-K 3-4. The lunch fee is DKK 600 per month. The subscription is for 11 months excluding July. The lunch fee for August is reduced to 300 DKK. To sign up, please use the lunch sign up sheet which is published here: <https://www.ish.dk/lunch>. To cancel your subscription, please use the lunch sign out form which is linked from the same page. Please note that if you cancel your child's lunch subscription you are required to pay the lunch fee for the running month + 1 month.

The lunch fee is added to the monthly programme fees. It is charged from August until June. The subscription fee is calculated based on the number of school days in a year and divided into a monthly rate. Therefore it is a flat rate each month, including months with school holidays such as August, October, December, February and April. Parents of students who are not enrolled in the school lunch service will be charged 50 DKK if the student forgets to bring lunch to school. Please note that if you decide to enroll for the lunch service after the monthly invoice has already been issued, the corresponding amount will be included in your invoice one month after your selection.

## Electives and Extra-Curricular Programme (Optional)

We offer a wide range of electives and extracurricular activities for students in the Primary School and Middle School. Please see our [Electives](#) page for more information and prices. The fees are paid directly to the activity teacher.

## Payment Policies

It is essential that school fees are paid on time. Additionally, according to auditing regulations and the provisions of the Ministry of Education, we cannot have outstanding student payment debts. Consequently, we cannot reserve a place in school for students whose fees are unpaid. To ensure fair treatment, we operate under the following policy at ISH:

1. **Direct Debit Signup:** It is mandatory to sign up for Direct Debit (PBS Betalingservice). Detailed information on how to set up direct debit can be found on the school website: <https://ib.ish.dk/admissions/tuition-fees>. If you need any assistance, please contact the school at +45 70 20 63 68 or enquire about the procedure at the school reception. In order to avoid these fees, you can make a quarterly payment. Failure to sign up will result in a monthly administration fee of DKK 500, which will be added to the school invoice after three months.
2. **Timely Payments:** Payments must be made in advance and no later than the first day of each month.
3. **Unpaid School Fees:** Any unpaid school fees will be carried forward and added to the invoice for the following month.
4. **Late Payment Reminders:** If a monthly invoice remains unpaid by the due date, ISH will send up to three late payment reminders.
5. **Withdrawal from School:** If school fees remain outstanding for 3 months, your child's place in the school may no longer be secure. In such a situation, your details will be passed on to the money collector Danskeinkasso, and you will be liable for all costs associated with this process.
6. **Payment of Fees in July:** Please note that both the school programme fee and the LSS fee are applicable for the entire year, including the month of July. If a family chooses to withdraw during the re-enrollment period, the July fees will be charged.
7. **Invoices:** You have the option to choose additional services, such as the After School Care Programme (ASCP) or Lunch Service. If you decide to enroll in any of these services after the monthly invoice has already been issued, the corresponding amount will be included in your invoice one month after your selection.

## Withdrawal Policy

The school deposit will be refunded if a withdrawal form ([available for download here](#)) is submitted with 3 months' notice. Parents who fail to provide sufficient notice will be charged school fees based on the date when the withdrawal form is submitted. If submitted by the 15th day of the month, school fees will be charged for that month and the two subsequent months. If submitted on the 16th day of the month or later, school fees will be charged for the month when notice was given and the three subsequent months. If necessary, the school deposit will be retained to cover a portion of the three-month payment. Please note that the withdrawal rules during the re-enrollment period (from March to August) are different - please see the Re-Enrollment section for more information.

Please note that the school deposit will not be refunded if you decide to withdraw your child before their first day of school. The deposit is only refundable if your child has started school at ISH, and you have notified the school three months in advance of the student's last day at the school.

## Re-Enrollment

During the Re-Enrollment period, which spans from March to August, there are specific rules regarding withdrawals. If you have outstanding school fees, you will not be able to re-enroll your child/children for the new school year.

If you choose not to re-enroll your child for the upcoming school year, your deposit will be utilised to cover the July school fees. Any remaining amount will be refunded to you, or alternatively, you may receive a final invoice if the fees exceed the deposit.

Please take note of the following important dates:

- If you have re-enrolled your child for the upcoming school year and later inform the admissions office by 1st June that you have changed your mind, your deposit will be forfeited, but you will not be charged tuition fees after July.
- If you inform the school between 1st June and 1st September, the three-month rule for withdrawal and tuition will apply. You will be charged school fees for three months and forfeit the deposit.

# Primary School Fees and Subsidies

## Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K) 3–4

### Subsidized School Fees

Please provide the CPR number and registered address from the yellow Health Insurance Card ("Sundhedskort") to the school promptly. The monthly school fees will be DKK 5,000 until we begin receiving subsidies from the municipality, which typically takes 1-3 months. Once the subsidies are confirmed, the fee will be reduced to DKK 4,700. According to Danish law, students in Pre-K 3-4 are considered as "Børnhave klasse", and we can apply for state funding on a monthly basis.

The school will apply for the school fee funding on the 1st of each month. The school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until we receive confirmation from the municipality regarding the subsidies. Once the subsidies are approved, your upcoming invoices will be adjusted accordingly. Please note that invoices cannot be retroactively changed.

### Important Notice Regarding Former Daycare (Børnhave) Sign-Out

Ensure that you officially sign out your child from their former daycare (Børnhave). If the student is not signed out, the school fee invoice will remain at DKK 5,000 until we receive confirmation from the municipality.

### Copenhagen Municipality (Københavns Kommune) Guidelines

All parents residing in Copenhagen municipality must read the information linked below and send the application form, along with the required documentation, to [info@ish.dk](mailto:info@ish.dk). **If the Copenhagen municipality does not accept the student for the integration law, the school fees will remain DKK 5,000 for the entire school year.**

### Moving to a New Municipality

In the event of your relocation to a different municipality, we kindly request that you promptly inform the school office. This notification is crucial as it enables us to initiate the application process for school funding from the new commune. Failure to inform the school office may potentially result in the loss of subsidies for your school fees.

### Additional Reductions for Pre-K Families

You can apply for parent subsidies in your municipality, "Pladsanvisning". This includes "Økonomisk Fripladstilskud" (based on household income) and "Søskenderabat" (Sibling Discount).

Contact your local municipality or kommune directly to inquire about the available subsidies. Please note that subsidies may vary between municipalities. Although there is no specific deadline for applications, we encourage you to apply as soon as possible after your child's enrollment. Subsidy grants will be paid directly to the school and will be retroactively deducted from the school fees.



## Mandatory Lunch Service

The lunch service is mandatory for Pre-Kindergarten. General information about the school lunch service and lunch fees can be found, along with specific details about Pre-K lunch, [here](#).

## Holiday Care Programme

During school holidays, such as the October Break, Winter Break, and February Break (please refer to the school calendar for specific holiday dates), parents have the opportunity to enroll their children in our Holiday Care Programme. To ensure their child's participation, parents must sign up for specific Holiday Care weeks by completing a form shared in the weekly parent newsletter prior to each Care week. It's important to note that Holiday Care is already included in the programme fees for Pre-Kindergarten 3–4 classes.

During the months of July and August, we provide a Summer Care Programme. This programme is also included in the programme fees for Pre-Kindergarten 3–4. Information regarding the Summer Care Programme will be communicated in the months leading up to the summer break. Parents will be requested to sign up for the programme through our designated summer programme portal.

## After School Care Programme (ASCP)

The After School Care Programme (ASCP) is an inclusive component of the programme fees for the Pre-Kindergarten 3–4 classes. Parents of children in these classes do not have to pay any additional fees to enroll their child in the ASCP. It is designed to provide a safe and engaging environment for students after regular school hours, ensuring their well-being and continued learning.

## Class Activity Fee

The Class Activity Fee covers expenses related to class field trips, educational events, and activities. The fee is DKK 300 per student per year and is deducted annually in October. Families enrolling their child(ren) during the academic year will be charged the Class Activity Fee when their child starts school.

## Class Fund/Klassekasse

The class fund/Klassekasse is collected by the class parent representative at the start of the school year. The amount to be collected is determined by the class parent representative after discussing with the teacher and other parents during the first class meeting. The class fund can be used for special activities, gifts, and arrangements within the class.

# Primary School Fees and Subsidies

## Kindergarten and Primary Years Programme (PYP) 1–5

### Programme Fees for New Students in Kindergarten and PYP 1-5:

1. Starting Before September 5th:
  - If we do not have your child's CPR number before the summer break, your first invoice will be issued for DKK 5,000.
  - If we receive your child's CPR number before September 5th, your invoice will be retroactively adjusted to reflect the subsidized fee.
  - If we receive your child's CPR number after September 5th, the school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until the end of the school year.
2. Starting After September 5th:
  - The school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until the end of the school year in July, regardless of whether we have received your child's CPR number. This is due to the fact that the school can only apply once a year for school funding for the student.

### Class Activity Fee

The Class Activity Fee covers expenses related to class field trips, educational events, and activities. The fee is DKK 300 per student per year and is deducted annually in October. Families enrolling their child(ren) during the academic year will be charged the Class Activity Fee when their child starts school.

### Class Fund/Klassekasse

The class fund/Klassekasse is collected by the class parent representative at the start of the school year. The amount to be collected is determined by the class parent representative after discussing with the teacher and other parents during the first class meeting. The class fund can be used for special activities, gifts, and arrangements within the class.

### PYP Therapy Services

We offer comprehensive therapy services to support students in behavioral, social, and emotional development. Our on-site therapist provides individualized assistance, including speech and occupational therapy services for articulation, communication, and sensory/motor difficulties. Accessing these services requires an evaluation to identify specific areas of need, and both the evaluation and therapy services have additional costs. Please note the following fees:

- Assessment for Speech and occupational therapy: DKK 4,000
- Speech, occupational therapy, behavioral, and achievement assessments: DKK 4,000 each

Therapy services are invoiced at a monthly rate of DKK 1,800 from September through June. This rate remains consistent each month, including during school holidays. Rescheduled sessions will be notified if a particular week is affected, but sessions missed due to student absence will not be made up.

## After School Care Programme (ASCP) Options and Fees

We offer an After School Care Program for Pre-Kindergarten to PYP 4 students, which includes daily activities and a small snack. There are two fee options for the ASCP:

- Full ASCP: Morning club and full-time ASCP until 17:00. Fee: DKK 1,600 per month
- Limited ASCP: Morning club and ASCP until 15.30. Fee: DKK 700 per month

ASCP fees are billed monthly for 11 months (August to June), with no charge in July. If your child is attending Pre-K, the ASCP fee is already included in the monthly school fee. Please note that the programme fees for August and September will be combined and reflected on the September invoice. If you enroll for ASCP after the monthly invoice is issued, the corresponding amount will be included in the next month's invoice.

## After School Care Programme (ASCP) Late Fees

If you are unable to collect your child on time, please contact the ASCP. Late pick-up more than once a month incurs a fee of DKK 200 per instance.

## Holiday Enrichments Camps and Care Programme

During school holidays, such as the October Break, Winter Break, and February Break (please refer to the school calendar for specific holiday dates), parents can enroll their children in our Holiday Care Programme for an additional fee. To secure their child's participation, parents must sign up for specific Care weeks by completing a form shared in the weekly parent newsletter prior to each Care week. The charges for the Holiday Care weeks are added to the school invoice one or two months after participation. In July and August, we provide a Summer Care Programme and a Summer Camp Programme. Details about these programs will be shared in the months leading up to the summer break. Since the summer programme is open to children from outside the school, the registration process differs from other Holiday Care weeks. Parents are required to register and make payments through our dedicated summer programme portal, using a credit card. It's important to note that full payment is required for registered weeks, regardless of whether the child attends all days.

## Parent Subsidies Kindergarten to PYP5 (Fripladstilskud - based on household income)

Parents of students from Kindergarten up to PYP 5 are eligible to apply for subsidies. The application form will be sent to parents via Toddle at the beginning of the school year, and printed copies will be available at the school reception starting from the first day of school. **Completed forms must be submitted no later than September 1st.** Subsidy grants will be evaluated by the Ministry of Children and Education in December. If approved, the funds will be directly paid to the school, and the subsidy amount will be deducted from the school fees from January/February to June.

## Transport Subsidy (PYP1 to MYP4)

If you reside more than 5 km away from the Hellerup campus, you have the option to apply for a transport subsidy. To apply, please send an email to [info@ish.dk](mailto:info@ish.dk), providing your child's name and address. The school will receive the subsidies in late December and deduct the approved amount from the January/February invoice.

## Middle School Fees and Subsidies (IB MYP 1–4)

### Programme Fees for New Students in MYP 1-4:

1. Starting Before September 5th:
  - If we do not have your child's CPR number before the summer break, your first invoice will be issued for DKK 5,000.
  - If we receive your child's CPR number before September 5th, your invoice will be retroactively adjusted to reflect the subsidized fee.
  - If we receive your child's CPR number after September 5th, the school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until the end of the school year.
2. Starting After September 5th:
  - The school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until the end of the school year in July, regardless of whether we have received your child's CPR number. This is due to the fact that the school can only apply once a year for school funding for the student.

### Middle School Tutors

We offer tutoring services to support our students in various subjects. If you are interested in arranging a meeting with a tutor or have any inquiries regarding the costs, please contact IB Coordinator for Middle Years Programme.

### Middle School Orientation Week

Orientation Week carries a fee associated with our pastoral program. This year, the fee is DKK 500, added to the August school invoice. Participation is mandatory for all middle school students. Detailed information will be provided by the advisory teacher in August. Attendance for all days of the orientation week is required and will be documented. Please note that this fee is non-refundable, unless otherwise stated.

### Middle School Core Week

The Core Week takes place during the spring term. It is mandatory for all MYP students and is an integral part of the curriculum. The total cost varies based on grade level, ranging from DKK 2,000 to DKK 7,000. Payment can be made in installments, and more information will be provided by the advisory teachers at the appropriate time. Please be aware that the cost of the trip is non-refundable, unless otherwise stated.

### Middle School Ski Trip

Middle school students are offered the chance to participate in a ski trip during week 10 in March. The cost of the trip will differ depending on the chosen destination, and specific details regarding the cost will be communicated by the Physical and Health Education (PHE) teachers in due course. For students who decide to join the trip, the payment will be divided into multiple installments over the months leading up to the excursion

### Middle School Math Competitions

Middle school students have the opportunity to participate in Math Competitions. The cost of participation will vary depending on the destination, and details will be communicated by the Math teachers at the appropriate time.

### Parent Subsidies MYP 1–4 (Fripladstilskud - based on household income)

Parents can apply for subsidies from the Ministry of Children and Education. The application form will be sent to parents via Toddle at the beginning of the school year, and printed copies will be available at the school reception starting from the first day of school. **Completed forms must be submitted no later than September 1st.** Subsidy grants will be evaluated by the Ministry of Children and Education in December. If approved, the funds will be directly paid to the school, and the subsidy amount will be deducted from the school fees from January/February to June.

### Transport Subsidy (PYP1 to MYP4)

If you reside more than 5 km away from the Hellerup campus, you have the option to apply for a transport subsidy. To apply, please send an email to [info@ish.dk](mailto:info@ish.dk), providing your child's name and address. The school will receive the subsidies in late December and deduct the approved amount from the January/February invoice

## High School Fees and Subsidies (IB MYP 5–DP2 and STX)

### High School Advisory Activities

There is a fee for major events and activities associated with the advisory and Core programs. The cost of the orientation week including the retreat and outings vary and will depend on the events selected by the HS team of staff. The costs are usually between DKK 500 and DKK 1,500. These fees are due in August. You get detailed information from the advisory teacher in August. All days of the orientation week are mandatory for all students and essential in launching our social emotional curriculum.

### High School Math Competitions and Model United Nations (MUN)

HS students can participate in Math Competitions and/or MUN. The cost varies depending on the destination and will be communicated by the teachers in-charge in due time.

### High School Tutors

We offer tutoring services to support our students in various subjects. If you are interested in arranging a meeting with a tutor or have any inquiries regarding the costs, please contact the High School Principal. The tutor fees are paid directly to the tutor.

### High School Trips

Costs vary depending on the destination selected. Costs of the trip will be communicated in due time and are sometimes to be covered by the parents. Cost for local trips in Denmark required within the subject curriculum will usually be covered by the school, or partially subsidized by the school.

### Transport Subsidy (Ungdomskort)

Students can apply for a transport subsidy card (Ungdomskort) on [www.ungdomskort.dk](http://www.ungdomskort.dk) using their NemID/MitID. The cost of the card can be found here: <https://www.ungdomskort.dk/priser/>. The Ungdomskort card provides transportation coverage within the capital region.

## IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) 5

### Programme Fees for New Students in MYP 5

1. Starting Before October 15th:
  - If we do not have your child's CPR number before the summer break, your first invoice will be issued for DKK 5,000.
  - If we receive your child's CPR between August and October 15th, your invoice will be retroactively adjusted to reflect the subsidized fee.
2. Starting After October 15th:
  - If we receive your child's CPR after October 15th, the school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until December.
3. Starting Between October 15th and December 31st:
  - The school fees will be DKK 5,000 until December, regardless of whether we have received your child's CPR number.
4. Starting in January:
  - If your child has a CPR number, the school fees will be the subsidised school fees.
  - If your child does not have a CPR number, the school fees will be DKK 5,000 until the end of the school year.

### MYP5 Core/Interdisciplinary Units (IDU) Week

The MYP5 Core/IDU Week is a mandatory part of the curriculum and takes place during the spring term. The total cost varies depending on the grade level, ranging between DKK 2,000 and DKK 7,000. Payment options may include installment plans. You will receive detailed information from the teachers in charge at the appropriate time. Please note that the cost of the trip is non-refundable, unless otherwise specified.

### MYP 5 Personal Project

For MYP5 students who start after October 20th, there is a registration fee of DKK 150 payable to the IB for the personal project.

### Parent Subsidies MYP5 (Fripladstilskud - depending on household income)

Parents of students in MYP that are under the age of 18 have the opportunity to apply for subsidies from the Ministry of Children and Education. The application period will be in October/November, and we will provide detailed information on the procedure through the weekly parent newsletter. If approved, the funds will be directly paid to the school, and the subsidy amount will be deducted from the December school fees.

## IB Diploma Programme (DP)

### Programme Fees for New Students in DP1:

Starting before December 5th

- If we do not have your child/children's CPR number before the summer break, your first invoice will be issued for the amount of DKK 5,000.
- If we receive your child's CPR before December 5th, your invoice will be retroactively adjusted to the subsidised fees.

Starting After December 5th:

- If we receive your child's CPR after December 5th, the school fees will remain DKK 5,000 until the end of the school year in July. This is due to the fact that the school can only apply once a year for school funding for the student.

### International Baccalaureate (IB) Fees

Students who are enrolled in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme are registered with the International Baccalaureate Organization. It is important to be aware that the Diploma Programme spans two years, and an IB Fee of DKK 300 per month will be charged until the completion of DP2. The IB Fee covers the costs for both years of the programme. However, it is crucial to note that if a student withdraws from the school before completing the full two-year programme, there will be no refund provided, either partially or in full, for the paid IB fees. Furthermore, if a student joins the programme after the academic year has already commenced, they will be charged retroactively for the IB fees.

### Diploma Programme Pamoja Fees

Pamoja Online Courses provide an opportunity for students to study subjects not formally offered at ISH. The cost for these courses is approximately 1220 EUR (9100 DKK) per course, per year. These fees are divided into three installments, which are charged in October, November, and December each year. For detailed pricing information, please visit the Pamoja website at:

### Diploma Programme Pamoja Late Registration Fee

Diploma Programme Students who start after 1st of September will need to pay 380 EUR (approximately DKK 2800) to be able to register in the IB even if they transfer from another school. This will be charged with the coming monthly fees.

### Diploma Programme Kognity Subscription (Optional)

ISH works with a company called Kognity that provides interactive, online textbooks, quizzes, resources and assessment practice papers to support student mastery of the curriculum in DP. Kognity is great for subjects like Science and Mathematics, but not so good for Languages and Arts. Accordingly, we let each family decide whether they want to purchase a subscription based upon the student's DP subject choices. A Kognity subscription will cost up to 200 USD (approximately DKK 1,500) per academic year and families will be given the option to sign up at the beginning of each year.



## High School Retreat / Introduction Week

The High School Retreat / Introduction Week carries a fee associated with our pastoral program. This year, the fee is DKK 450 for student in MYP5, and DKK 950 for students in the Diploma Programme, added to the August school invoice. Participation is mandatory for high school students. Detailed information will be provided by the advisory teacher in August. Attendance for all days of the orientation week is required and will be documented. Please note that this fee is non-refundable, unless otherwise stated.

## Parent Subsidies DP (Fripladstilskud - depending on household income)

You can apply for subsidies from the Ministry of Children and Education. The application period will be in October/November, and we will provide detailed information on the procedure through the weekly parent newsletter. If approved, the funds will be directly paid to the school, and the subsidy amount will be deducted from the school fees at the end of the school year in May/June.

## SU – Educational Support

Students who are 18 years or older have the option to apply for SU, which provides financial support for education. Approximately one month before turning 18, students can submit their application for SU. To do so, they will need a NemID to log in to either [www.borger.dk](http://www.borger.dk) or [www.su.dk](http://www.su.dk) and apply online. Please note the following:

- For non-Danish citizens, there will be an additional section to complete in order to apply for equalization. Documentation such as a residency permit, copy of a passport, or similar proof will be required.
- It is important for students to have a NemKonto, which is a bank account connected to their CPR number. They should check with their bank to ensure they have a NemKonto.
- If students are living independently, separate from their parents, they will need to provide proof of this arrangement.
