

**USE OF SCHOOL-OWNED REAL ESTATE FOR
TELECOMMUNICATIONS INSTALLATIONS**

The Board of Education may enter into a lease agreement for the use of district real estate and buildings to provide for the installation, maintenance and use of telecommunications equipment and low power radio signal equipment owned by private service providers.

In considering such a lease, district staff shall review the health and safety, aesthetic and structural ramifications of the proposed installations and make recommendations to the Board. All such installations will also be reviewed conceptually and for final approval according to the planning processes of the local governmental jurisdictions in which the installations are proposed.

Revenues from such lease agreements shall go toward ongoing telecommunications operating costs incurred district wide including any legal costs associated with establishing and maintaining the lease agreements.
