

ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND SAFETY PROCEDURES

The Board of Education believes that an effective risk management program is essential to help protect people from personal injury and to preserve the District's facilities and equipment. To promote the protection of the public, district personnel and assets, the Board encourages preventive actions to identify and minimize potential loss exposures.

The Superintendent is responsible for the implementation of procedures and the supervision of personnel to promote the goals of preserving District assets and providing a safe environment, and may delegate activities for minimizing loss exposure to personnel who will:

1. Secure adequate insurance coverage designed to finance losses that occur.
2. Initiate and coordinate programs to raise employee/student safety awareness and lower the frequency and severity of accidents/injuries and property loss.
3. Recognize individuals, schools and departments for demonstrating outstanding safety and loss control practices.
4. Review and revise district safety policies.
