

CLASSIFIED STAFF REPRESENTATIVE LEAVE

The Board believes that good communication between classified staff, administrators and the Board may solve problems, improve mutual understanding and help all parties do their jobs more effectively. Therefore, the district shall provide paid leave to the chairperson of the classified staff advisory council who is authorized to use up to 50% of his or her assignment time to further such communication. In the chairperson's absence from his/her staff duties, a substitute shall be obtained in the usual manner and paid by the district, as needed.
