

STUDENT REPORT CARDS/PROGRESS REPORTS

The Board of Education believes that report cards are an effective and vital form of communication between schools and parents. The district therefore shall endeavor to see that these measures of accomplishment are as informative and useful as possible.

Methods of reporting student progress shall be as provided on district forms developed by the professional staff and approved by the Board. Teachers are urged not to rely on the form as the sole or major source of reporting student progress to parents.
