

PREGNANT/MARRIED STUDENTS

Pregnancy or marriage shall not affect the rights of students to receive a public education or their opportunities to take part in co-curricular activities or honors offered by their school, nor shall they be exempt from district graduation requirements or from the regulations governing other students.

A student who becomes pregnant may either continue attending her home school or enroll in the district Teen Parent Program for as long as her physician considers advisable. If or when her physician and/or school counselor advise against her full participation in the regular school program, she should meet with appropriate district personnel to develop an educational program designed to meet her special needs.

Pregnant middle school students who take teen parenting classes at the district alternative high school do not thereby become eligible to attend the other classes it offers.
