

CONTESTS FOR STUDENTS

The Board of Education recognizes the personal and academic value of some requests for local, state and national organizations to sponsor contests in the schools and appreciates the interest in the schools that such requests reveal. At the same time, the Board recognizes its responsibility for maintaining a planned, balanced educational program and does not condone contest activities which tend to disrupt, or are unrelated to, the planned programs of instruction.

Therefore, non-school organizations must request permission from Student Achievement Services to sponsor educational contests in the schools and must receive such permission before students may participate in their contests under district auspices.
