

## **PUBLIC GIFTS/DONATIONS TO DISTRICT**

A gift, emolument, gratuity or donation which relates to the purpose of school activities may be accepted if it has any substantial economic value, provided that it is done in accordance with the accompanying procedures.

Authority to accept a gift, donation, emolument, gratuity or favor to the district shall be vested in the Board of Education but may be delegated to the schools for gifts of smaller value that are intended to be used at an individual school.

All such gifts, whether to an individual school or to the school district, shall become the property of the district and if identical or similar to items which appear on standardized lists, shall be considered a part of the regular formula when replacement is necessary.
