

EDUCATIONAL CABLE TELEVISION CHANNEL

The Board of Education recognizes the great potential educational value of an instructional cable television channel. It supports such a channel as a means of showing student accomplishments to the public, a medium for professional development for staff members and as a way to broaden public understanding of district programs and issues.

To provide students with appropriate guidance in using this tool and to protect individuals and the school district from potential harm associated with its use; the Board directs the Television and Video Services Manager or his/her designee(s) to develop rules, regulations, guidelines and procedures for the use of instructional cable television.

In keeping with the district's interest in developing community partnerships, the Board wishes to grant limited programming opportunities on the instructional television channel to non-district agencies, organizations or individuals whose stated purposes are consistent with Board policy and district guidelines. Access to the district programming facilities will be only at the invitation of the district.

Should a disagreement arise regarding the use of district cable facilities, the superintendent will make the final determination.
