

## **RELATIONS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES**

The police forces of the jurisdictions in which district schools are located, including but not limited to, all their officers and personnel whether on duty or off, in uniform or in civilian clothes, shall be granted full right and authority to enter upon any lands and places owned and operated by the school district for the purpose of keeping the peace and enforcing all ordinances in the same manner and with the same force and effect as they could do on property not belonging to the school district.

The Board authorizes the police department in whose jurisdiction the high school campuses are located to issue tickets to vehicles illegally parked on the campuses.

If the police wish to interrogate students during the school day or on school grounds, they shall follow the board-adopted policy for such interrogations.
