How will we measure?	55% of students in Grades K-5 at Clover Ridge Elementary will meet or exceed the average grade level growth as measured by Areading and Ereading FastBridge Assessments.
What are we doing?	 Implement new Reading Curriculum (Being a Reader K-2, Units of Study 3-5) Implement new Writing Curriculum (Being a Writer, 4-5) Implement instructional best practices integrating Math Expressions with fidelity. Provide best fit interventions to support academic growth. Progress Monitor students throughout the year and adjust supports accordingly. Monitor BAS levels to track reading progress Ensure a safe learning environment for all learners
What will you notice?	 Increased confidence, proficiency and building-wide student achievement

How will we measure?	 Monitor progress of students' social, academic and emotional needs and how students, staff, and parents feel about their Clover Ridge Experience.
What are we doing?	 Ensure a Morning Meeting experience to support the social, academic, emotional growth and development Social worker is conducting 1 minute interviews to monitor how students feel about themselves, school, and can identify a trusted adult.
What will you notice?	 Students will have at least one adult they can go to if they have a concern. All stakeholders feel seen, heard, valued, and trusted.
