

Disposal, Rental, or Lease of Property Policy

The sale, exchange, lease and disposition of property belonging to Woods Charter School are governed by Section 115C-518 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, which incorporates the provisions of Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes.

The Woods Charter School Board has the authority to establish policies regarding the sale, exchange, and disposition of school property and the conduct of school employees with regard to the sale, exchange, disposition, and purchase of school property.

The Board delegates to the Principal or his designee the authority to dispose of school property, in accordance with state law. If the material involved is determined to have saleable value, the Principal or his designee shall arrange for the sale of the material. In the event that the material does not have saleable value, the Principal or his designee shall determine the proper disposal of the material, and the equipment deemed obsolete will be replaced with existing equipment or by new equipment at the discretion of the Principal or his designee.
