
BOND UPDATE #209

Here's what is going on with our bond projects.

- 1. The finishing touches on the Grandstands' press box should be completed over the next couple of weeks.
- 2. Fencing work continues around the Athletic Field area and should be finished in the next few weeks.
- 3. Crews have laid the asphalt for the track. The next step is to apply the rubberized surface, and it will almost be complete!
- 4. Good progress has been made on the long jump, javelin, shot put, and discus areas. These should be finished over the next few weeks.
- 5. The masonry block has been installed on the exterior of the Athletic Field's ticket booth. Crews will now apply the final finishes.
- 6. The new CTE Wing's roofing is almost complete, along with the exterior sheathing. Interior framing work is now more than 90% finished, and the concrete slab has been poured in the mechanical mezzanine area.
- 7. The brick columns around the posts under the canopy (which will connect the Athletic and Academic wings) are now complete, and the area is ready to receive decorative fencing. This will create a nice courtyard area while providing a secure perimeter throughout the school day.
- 8. Crews continue to install curbing and gutters around the new parking areas. These areas are scheduled to have asphalt installed during the month of August.
- 9. The Bond Oversight Committee will hold their next meeting at 6 p.m. on Tuesday at Mountain View.
