- Who took the survey:
 - Elementary Families: 55 submissions (out of 326 of students)
 - Middle School Families: 84 submissions (out of 190 of students)
 - High School Families: 45 submissions (out of 232 of students)
- Data was taken during a mental health crisis
- The link was made public (which is standard), but this also means, there is no quarantee only JSD parents filled out the survey and that each respondent did it once
- Percentages show the number of participants chose a 4 (agree) or a 5 (strongly agree) out of the total participants, per school
- The data shown are direct screenshots of what we see. No data has been altered or modified, other than adding the color coded boxes (see below)
