- Minimum Instructor Pay (MIP) Annual Rate + Commissioned/Noncommissioned Officer Pay = Annual Salary
- The amount of monthly MIP is determined by the Military as required by Public Law 88-647. The law requires that an instructor be paid no less than the difference between the active duty pay and allowances the employee would receive if on active duty, minus his/her gross military retirement pay; this amount is referred to as MIP.
