## WHY OUR SCHOOL

The Class of 2022's overall four-year graduation rate was Dublin High School's highest ever at **96.2%** - well above the state average of 84.1%! In fact, out of the 180+ school districts in all of Georgia, Dublin City Schools finished in the top 18%. 2022 was also the third year in a row that Dublin City Schools posted a 90+ point graduation rate. In fact, the district has improved its four-year graduation rate by nearly 22 points, up from 73.6% to 95.5%, over the past 10 years.



## EXTRACURRICULARS

Outside of the classroom, Dublin High School has outstanding athletic programs - including Baseball, Basketball, Cheerleading, Competition Dance, Cross Country, E-Sports, Golf Football, Tennis, Track, Soccer, Softball, Volleyball and Wrestling. Additionally, the arts are one of the high school's points of pride thanks to its award-winning band, dance and theatre programs. Since 2006, Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps has been a thriving addition to Dublin High School, while Future Farmers of America promotes agricultural education and SkillsUSA is a partnership of students, teachers and industry leaders working together to ensure Dublin-Laurens County has a skilled workforce.

## CURRICULUM

Each semester, our Dublin High Schoolers take four classes, totaling 32 credits between their Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior Year. However, only 24 credits are required to graduate. This means, each student's schedule has built-in time for them to take elective courses like a modern language, fine arts, personal fitness, complimentary coursework and extended learning opportunities. Additionally, they can take career education classes through Dublin High School's College and Career Academy, commonly referred to as The WAY. Course offerings for the 2023-2024 school year include: **Agriculture, Air Force JROTC, Business & Technology, Career Skills, Certified Nursing Assistant, Construction, Cosmetology, Criminal Justice, Food Sciences, Mechatronics, Teaching as a Profession and Welding.**
