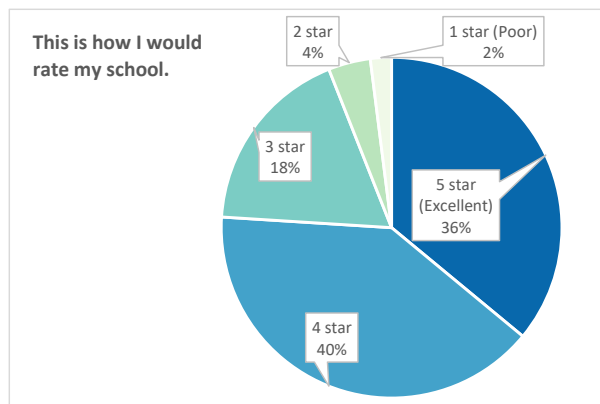

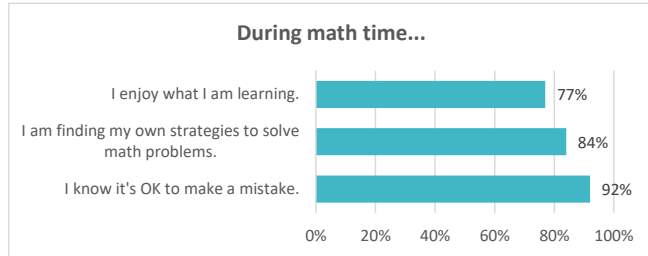

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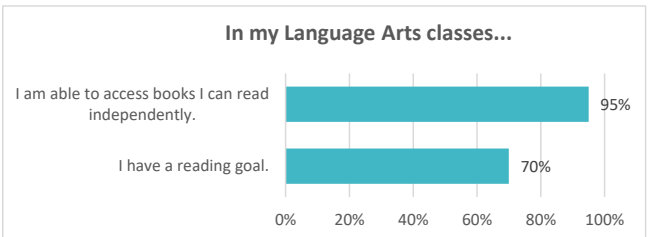

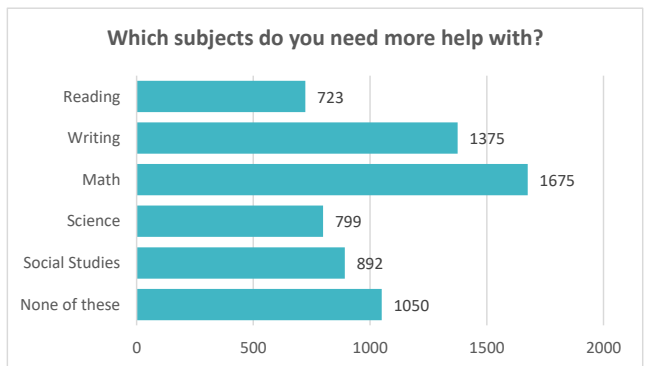

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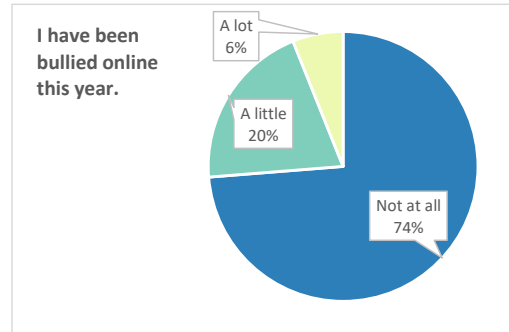
One reason students sometimes don't feel safe is that they get bullied by other students.

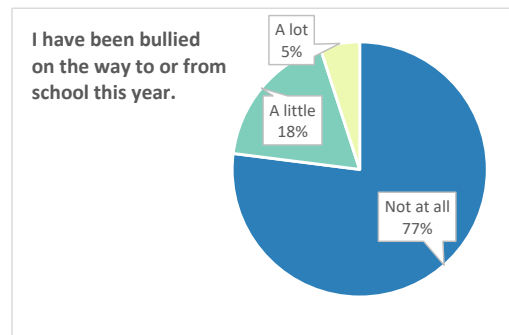

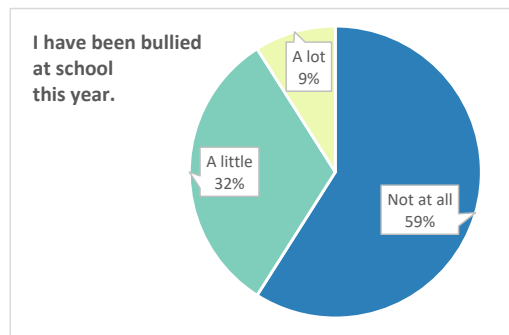

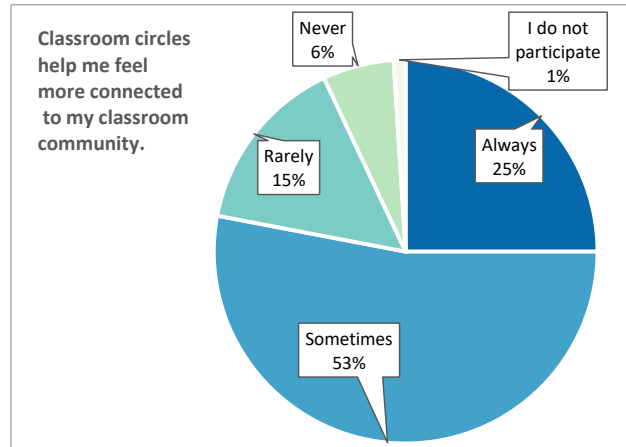

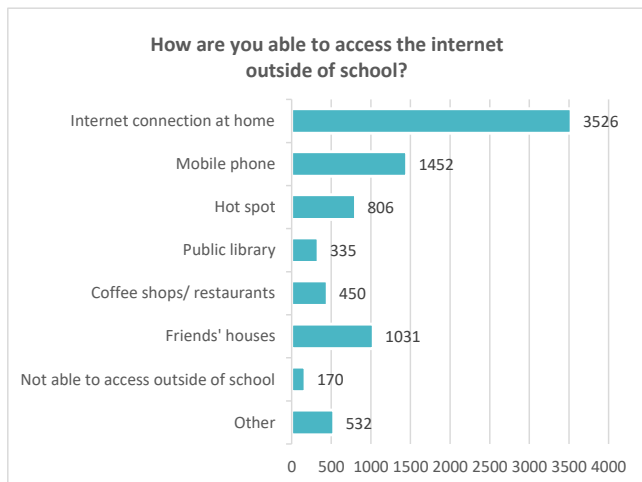
