

## Running Start & High School Equivalency

\*Meets most high school equivalencies for local area schools. Students should always verify course equivalency with high school counselor.

High School Requirement	
English – Language Arts 11 A/B	ENGL& 101 – English Composition 1 COMP 100 – Applied Composition
English – Language Arts 12 A/B	ENGL& 101 – English Composition 1 Any English class <u>above</u> ENGL& 101
<b>Social Studies</b>  US History A/B	HIST 110 – Survey of US History
Civics/CWI A/B	POLS& 202 – American Government POLS& 203 – International Relations POLS 150 – Critical Issues/World Politics
<b>Health</b>	NUTR& 101 – Human Nutrition
<b>Math – 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Equivalency</b>	AMATH 195 – Advanced Applied Algebra
<b>Math (other)</b>	Generally any 100+ level Mathematics course. Verify with your high school counselor.
<b>Fine Arts</b>	Generally any Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Photography or Graphic Art class. Verify with high school counselor.
<b>World Language</b>	Any World Language (including American Sign Language) offered at community or technical college.
<b>Career &amp; Tech Education</b>	Generally any 100+ level Business, Accounting, Administrative Office Systems, Business Administration, Computer Science, Early Childhood Education, Education, Business Management, Information Technology, Interior Design, Marketing, Media Communications & Tech, Real Estate.
<b>Science</b>	Generally any 100+ level Science course.

**Please note:** Common Course Numbers (CCN) are designated with the “&” symbol. 5 college credits = 1 HS credit; 3 college credits = 0.6 HS credit; 2 college credits = 0.4 HS credit; 1 college credit = 0.2 HS credit. Minimum Green River College grade to earn credit for high school is 1.0.

Courses meeting high school graduation requirements may not meet University Entrance Requirements.

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
