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| Read a book to (or with) someone for 10 minutes and/or practice reading your sight words list five times. | Orally count numbers from 0 to 100 by 1's, 5's, or 10's while hopping up and down or doing jumping jacks. | Draw a map of your home or bedroom and label it. | Write your sight word list or the alphabet in a creative way (Rainbow write, fancy letters, play dough, etc.) | PE: Play outside for 20 minutes or more (weather permitting) or do 10 minutes of GoNoodle activities: https://www.youtube.com/user/GoNoodleGames |
| Read a cereal box, newspaper, child magazine, or words around the house. | Play a board game or card game with someone. | Get a bunch of empty containers and as a scientist create your own pretend mixtures. | Retell a story you read using the words First, Next, Then, and Last. | ART: Choose a "how to draw" video https://www.artforkidshub.com/how-to-draw/ or draw your favorite animal and its habitat. |
| Put together a 25 piece (or more) puzzle. | Play the game of "War" with a deck of cards with the highest card winning. Play "Slap Jack" with a deck of cards. | Practice writing your first and last name. Practice saying your telephone number, and address. | Write a thank you note to someone special. | STEM: Write down whether the weather is cloudy, sunny, rainy, snowy, windy, foggy, and the temperature. |
| Name all your stuffed animals with rhyming names, such as "Doggie Boggie" "Kitty Gitty" | Find three things of each shape in your house. Circle, square, rectangle, triangle, trapezoid, hexagon. | Help make homemade play dough <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2 cups plain flour (all purpose) 2 tablespoons vegetable oil (baby oil and coconut oil work too) 1/2 cup salt. 2 tablespoons cream of tartar. 1 in 1.5 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels just right) food coloring (optional) few drops glycerine (my secret ingredient for stretch and shined) | Write a complete telling sentence with a period at the end. | LIBRARY: Listen to a story https://www.youtube.com/user/StorylineOnline |
