

AIM College and Career Prep Student Dress Code 2023-2024 Grades 7th - 12th

AIM College and Career Prep does not require students to wear uniforms. There is however a dress code in which students must follow. Consequences will vary according to the severity of the offense. With minor issues, the first goal is simply to fix the situation. If student(s) cannot or refuse to adhere to the dress code, discipline consequences such as lunch detention or ISS will be assigned depending on the nature and severity of the issue.

Student ID	All AIM students are required to wear a picture ID card at all times. The ID is to be worn around the neck on a lanyard. Students must show their ID to enter the building. All students will be issued a picture ID card when they enroll at AIM for the first time. If a card is lost, it can be replaced for a \$5.00 fee at the attendance office. If the student cannot pay the \$5.00 fee, a fine will be assessed in Skyward. In addition, a paper temporary ID good for only one day may be issued. The charge is \$1.00 per incident.
Shirt	Shirt design may not display alcohol or drug slogans or other suggestive or inappropriate designs including but not limited to those that promote or suggest sex, violence, etc. Unacceptable shirts include muscle shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, see through, backless, shoulderless, and low cut tops. Shirts showing the midriff are not allowed.
Undergarments	No undergarments (bras, underwear, panties, boxers, gym shorts, etc.) should be visible.
Pants Shorts Skirts	Leggings and athletic pants are allowed if tasteful in appearance and appropriate in coverage. Clothing should not be excessively tight and/or revealing. Jeans should not have rips or tears above the knee. Pants must fit at the waist and be appropriately sized. No pajama pants allowed. No bike shorts allowed. All pants/shorts/skirts should not be shorter than fingertip length. Holes above the fingertips will not be allowed.
Shoes	Shoes must be worn in the building. No house shoes, thin slippers, or shoes with wheels are allowed.
Outerwear	May not display alcohol or drug slogans or other suggestive or inappropriate designs, including but not limited to those that promote or suggest sex, violence, etc. No hoods can be worn in the building.
Backpacks	Students may use a backpack in the building.

Accessories	Head-wear and hats of any kind are not to be worn in the building (including but limited to scarves, beanies, caps, do-rags, bonnets) Sunglasses must be removed upon entering the building. Non-approved items will be requested to be put away. With repeated issues in the same day, the item could be confiscated for the remainder of the day. No accessories that could cause an injury or are disruptive are allowed.
Spirit Days	On Spirit Days, students are encouraged to wear jeans with a spirit shirt. Monday Students have the option of wearing an AIM spirit shirt. Wednesday Students have the option of wearing a shirt promoting kindness. Friday Students have the option of wearing a college/university shirt.
