I asked myself, " what was the most challenging thing for me during my four years at SPA?". Through self-examination I concluded that it had to be my living in two cultures-Hmong and American and learning how to balance them. It was a challenge well worth the fight because what resulted was something irreplaceable.

Often times living in two cultures is a question of how much do you assimilate and how much do you retain of your own culture. In the ninth grade my answer to this was quite simple. I should totally assimilate to the American culture and retain nothing of my own. I was narrow minded and insecure. I thought that my only choice was to chose one world over the other and I obviously chose the more popular one. I was at the stage of life where the approval of my peers was the most important thing. By choosing to be completely American, to fit in at school I denied my identity and heritage. My family and relatives began to notice my change. My cousins called me a white wannabe and my parents didn't like it either. They didn't understand why I rebelled against my own culture. An example was when I went against my custom and permed my hair. I wasn't supposed to because it's considered more attractive for a Hmong girl to have her hair long and straight. My mom was upset by this. She thought that I would get a bad reputation in the Hmong community. In my acts of rebellion I was really rebelling against my identity but at the time I didn't know it.

My suppression of my own identity confused me. I found my behavior contradictory and sometimes absurd. In school I was quite cooperative, and hardworking. But at home I was completely the opposite. I fought with my family to show myself that I was different from them. I didn't eat rice so as to distance myself from my Hmong culture. I didn't understand why I behaved this way. I didn't know what roles to play anymore. However, this confusion was lessened in the tenth grade.

Tenth grade was the turning point where I found my identity. It opened my eyes to the beauty of my culture. Expository Writing class with Mrs. Slocum helped me to see this. She encouraged me to write about myself and so I did. I wrote an essay that documented my family's escape from the jungles of Laos to Thailand during the Vietnam War. This forced me to realize that a part my identity came from that experience and that I should be proud of it because not many people can survive such an ordeal. Another piece of my work dealt with seeing things from my mother's perspective. I learned that the most valuable possession I own is my identity and it's about the only thing that can't be taken away from me. The two pieces gave me renewed admiration and
