

Supply List for Incoming Second Grade

Dear Parents,

Your child will need the following supplies for second grade. Please send these items in during the week of August 28, 2023. Please label your bag with your child's name, grade, and teacher. These are the items that you will need to purchase at your favorite retailer:

- Backpack with name, grade, and Rev. Brown (Rolling backpacks are not allowed)
- A box of washable markers
- One folder with pockets (For Spanish)
- 4 Wide Ruled **Composition** Notebooks (1 black, 1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow) ***No Spiral***
- A standard size clipboard
- 2 boxes of no more than 24 crayons
- Two 24-pack of **sharpened** #2 pencils and an eraser
- One small personal pencil sharpener
- Blunt-edge scissors labeled with name
- 24-glue sticks (please label each with name)
- A small art box (no larger than 5 ½" x 8 ½" x 2 ½")
- An art smock ***Labeled with your child's name***
- A personal set of ear-buds labeled with name in a separate plastic bag or pouch
- 2 black Expo Markers (dry- erase) and a sock to use as an eraser
- 2 highlighters
- 2 containers of baby wipes
- 2 containers of disinfectant wipes (Clorox, Lysol, etc.)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 box of tissues

Supplies MUST be assembled as followed:

In your child's art box please place one pair of labeled scissors, 1 eraser, 5 sharpened pencils, 3 labeled glue sticks, 1 expo marker, 1 highlighter, and 1 box of crayons into the art box as well.

Remaining supplies must be removed from their containers and labeled with your child's name. Place remaining supplies in a 1-gallon zip-lock bag with your child's name labeled clearly on the front of the bag.

The following are items your child will purchase at school:

Assignment pad, two primary notebooks, homework folder, and classwork folder.

Please do not send in any money until you are notified on the first day of school of the exact amount and the procedure for payment.
