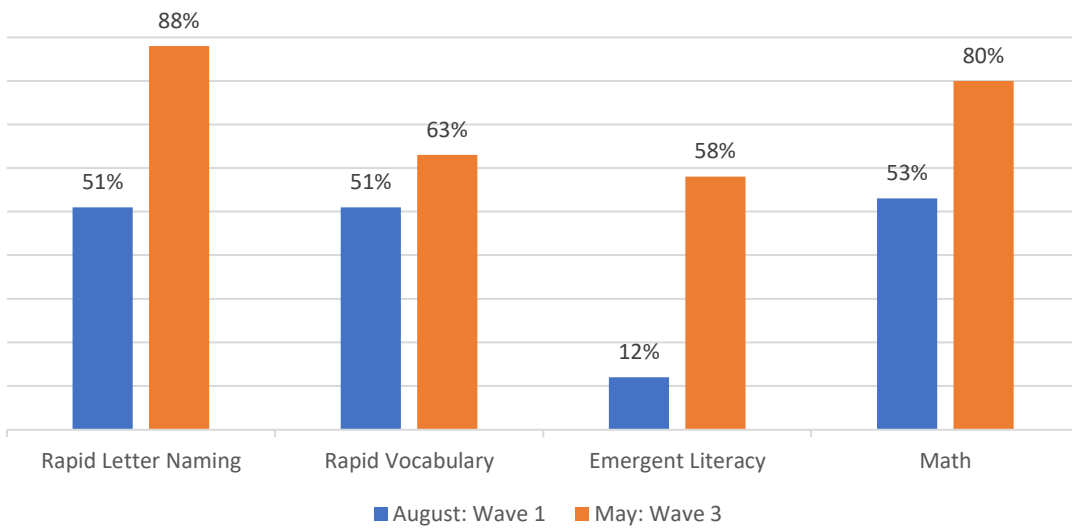
## Opportunities to Grow

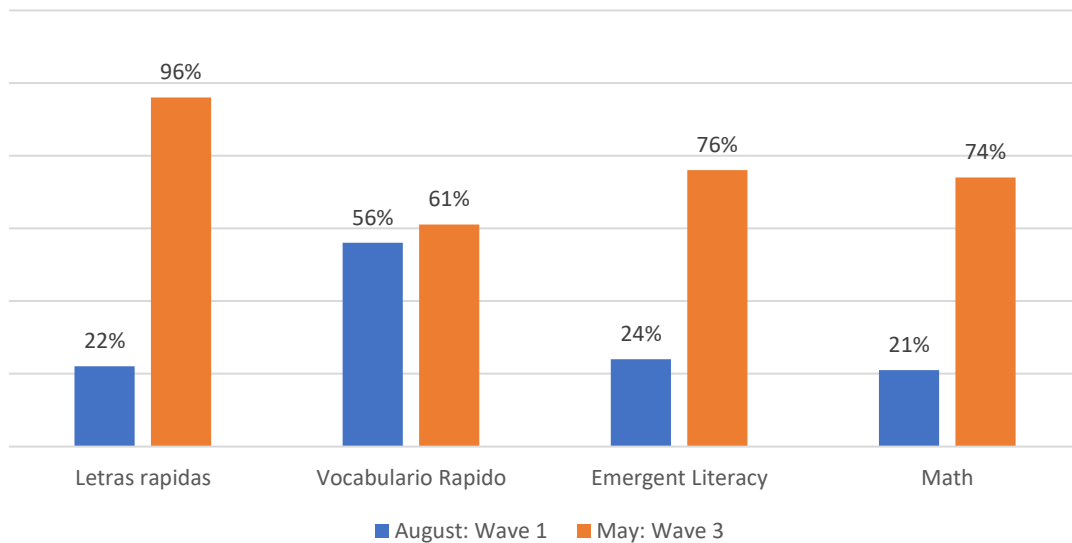
## Next Steps for Continuous Improvement
