

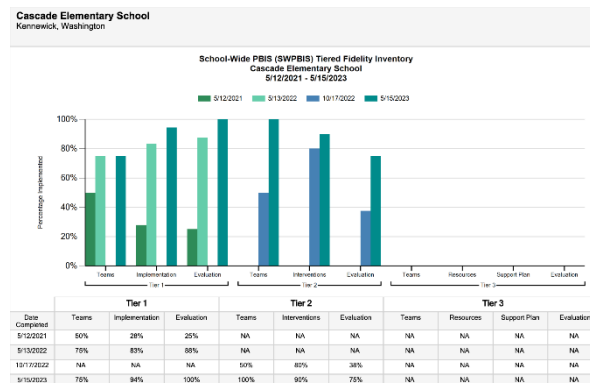
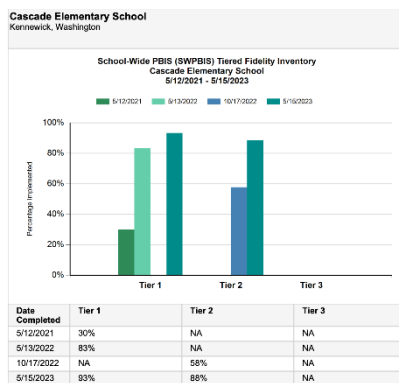

How do students access Tier II Interventions?

Families and staff members can complete a request for assistance indicating the student's need for additional supports. Students are generally identified through office discipline referrals, attendance issues, difficulty in school, or our bi-annual SEL screener. The Tier II team reviews referrals weekly and makes decisions about which Tier II interventions would best fit the student. Parents are notified prior to students beginning a Tier II intervention.

What is the status of PBIS implementation?

The TFI indicates that we are implementing both Tier I and Tier II with fidelity. Within the core features, we are strong in all areas, but can work on improving our Tier I team and our Tier II evaluations.



How effective are our Tier II Interventions?

Intervention	# of students	# of students meeting goal	% Successful
Check In Check Out	36	31	86%
Social Skills Groups	37	31	84%
Zones Groups	24	19	79%

What is our Action Plan for the next school year?

In reviewing our behavioral attendance data, we have the following goals:

- We will develop a Cascade Tier II Planning Calendar
- We will create a written process for teachers to refer students to Tier II Interventions
- We will share at least annually our progress with Tier II with families/community
