

Summary of Changes to Standard T&Cs (August 2023)

Clause Number	Changes Made
3.3	Vaccinations: Mandatory vaccination fulfilment or exemptions as a prerequisite for enrolment (not application to the College) and for entry to Singapore, as well as for school trips, has been clarified.
3.9.1	Child safeguarding: in addition to the previous clause, a new section has been added specifying 'Interim Measures' that the College can impose in cases of alleged child on child abuse that may affect both the 'Complainant' and the 'Respondent' as well as their close contacts.
New 3.9.3	Police reports: a new clause has been added to allow the College to postpone its own inquiry in the case of a police report in relation to a safeguarding incident, until the police have completed their investigation.
New 3.9.4	Police reports: a new clause has been added stating that the College will report to the police any alleged incidents that fall within Section 424 of the Criminal Procedure Code.
New 6.6	Withdrawal/Reinstatement: a new clause has been added specifying the timeline for a reinstatement to the College following a withdrawal.
9.6	Exclusion from Boarding: this clause has been amended to add clarity for families about term fees and boarding fees that will be forfeited following exclusion from boarding for disciplinary or other reasons, depending on whether or not the student continues to attend the College as a day student.
10.5.3	Failure to disclose Singapore Citizenship (or pending application) during the admissions process: an additional section has been added to this clause prohibiting a re-application for the next two admissions cycles.
10.5.4	Acquisition of Singapore Citizenship while enrolled at the College but prior to MOE P1 registration: an additional section has been added to this clause prohibiting a re-application for the next two admissions cycles, following the child's required withdrawal from the College.
