10 11		Il procedure for filing a complaint is as follows, details can be found in regulation rocess for Responding to Requests for Reconsideration of School Resources:

13	1.	The complaint should be filed in writing with the principal on the "Request for			
14		Reconsideration of Learning Resources" form KLB-E. This form may be obtained			
15		from the principal or the Central Office, or online from the school division			
16		website.

18	2.	A review committee will convene. The responsibilities of the committee will be to:			
19		1			
20		a. read, view and/or listen to the challenged material;			
21		b. read several reviews, if available;			
22		c. check standard selection aids;			
23		d. talk with persons who may be knowledgeable about the material in			
24		question and similar material;			
25		e. review academic research on child development and learning, and the			
26		quality of the material in supporting child development;			
27		f. discuss the material and its impact on students of various identities within			
28		the classroom;			
29		g. make a decision to recommend retaining or withdrawing the material;			
30		h. file the recommendation of the committee with the principal and the			
31		Superintendent or designee;			
32		i. notify the person making the complaint of its recommendation and the			
33		disposition of the challenged material.

35	3.	The complainant may appeal the decision, in turn, to the Superintendent or			
36		designee and then, to the School Board.

38	Resources will not be removed during the reconsideration process.
